# Poultry

- Exhibit entry required by July 14, 2022.
- Entry Check-in: July 21, 8:00 am to noon
- Judging: Thursday, July 21 at 5:00 pm
- Release: Sunday, July 24 at 8:00 am
- 1. Entry forms may be obtained from the fair secretary, website, open class entry form in premium book, or register online at *MorrisonCountyFair-MN.fairentry.com*.
- 2. Entry fees must be submitted with the entry form. Entry Fee is \$1.00 per class. Management may accept entries after the date specified above if there is available space in the showroom, late entry fees are doubled.
- 3. Exhibitors must be bona fide owners of the birds.
- 4. Birds will be pen judged. Open class exhibitors do not need to be present during judging. However, open class birds also exhibited in 4-H will need to be temporarily moved to pens in the open class area at the time of open class judging. 4-H birds not moved for open class judging will be disqualified.
- 5. Birds may not be shown in more than 1 division/ class
- 6. Birds must qualify according to the American Standard of Perfection to receive a premium. The judge is authorized to disqualify birds not meeting the Standard of Perfection
- 7. Leg bands will be provided for fowl not previously banded
- 8. Woodchips, drinking and feed cups will be provided. Exhibitors must care for birds unless arrangements are made with poultry staff in advance.
- 9. All birds shall be free from any infectious communicable diseases, sick or diseased birds will be removed.
- 10. Morrison County Fair is not responsible for losses or damages.
- 11. Management reserves the right to modify guidelines to ensure a successful show.

### POULTRY EXCEPT WATERFOWL:

Must be accompanied by an official form identifying the bird by using the leg band and with a record of a negative test for Pullorum-Typhoid conducted within 90 days prior to the entry to the exhibition or a record from parent stock tested negative within 12 months prior to entry to the exhibition. Turkeys must be accompanied by an official form indicating they were tested for Mycoplasma Gallispecticum and Mycoplasmas Synoviae or have originated from a hatchery that is classified clean of these diseases. Free Pullorum testing will be available during registration for birds Hatched prior to Jan1 or bring not originating from a certified hatchery.
