Swimming Lessons:

Early Spring swim lessons began March 3, with 35 participants registered.

Community Band

Community Band must have the instruments out of the current property by the end of the month. Charlie got approval from WPT to temporarily store the instruments at the West End Fire House and for a storage shed to be placed on the property behind Target. Charlie also spoke to Trisha about a possible grant for the purchase of a shed.

Bill suggested we discuss free or inexpensive storage options and/or fundraising ideas to raise funds for the shed.

The band currently has 6 paid concerts scheduled for the Spring/Summer season and this will generate \$1,800 in donations. They will perform another 4-5 holiday concerts at the end of the year, generating another \$1,200-\$1,500. This is a minimum of \$3,000 for this year.

Costs for the band include Band Director's Salary, insurance and Ice Cream for their last summer concert. While the donations received cover these costs, there is not much left over. "Approximately \$600 may be left"
