Show Information



About High School Musical Jr

Disney Channel's smash hit movie musical comes to life on stage in Disney's High School Musical JR. Troy, Gabriella and the students of East High must deal with issues of love, friends and family while balancing their classes and extracurricular activities. The show's infectious, danceable songs will engage performers and audiences alike.

It's the first day after winter break at East High. The Jocks, Brainiacs, Thespians and Skater Dudes all find their cliques. Basketball team captain and resident jock Troy discovers that the brainy Gabriella, a girl he met singing karaoke on his ski trip, has just enrolled at East High. The couple causes an upheaval when they decide to audition for the high school musical. Although many students resent the threat posed to the "status quo," Troy and Gabriella's alliance might also open the door for others to shine.

Show duration – 60 minutes plus a 20-minute intermission.

Audition Information

All auditionees must fill out an audition form before attending their audition time. Auditions will occur in The Singers Shed with a designated waiting area outside. We ask that you come suitably attired to your audition as you may be invited to experiment with characterised movement. Please arrive 10 minutes before your audition time.

The audition panel will consist of the director and creative team members. An independent person will be present in your audition to ensure all auditioners are treated equitably. It is in the panel's best interest for all auditionees to be successful and supported.

Preparing for the audition may include understanding the plot, the character's role, relationship with others and any physical characteristics you can demonstrate in the audition. Read through the character breakdown document before selecting a character/s and script. Familiarise yourself with the chosen script for your chosen character. Auditionees do not need to memorise the scripts; however, a strong knowledge and familiarity with the text will ensure a confident audition.

- Ask questions before the audition day to ensure you know everything you need.
- Be open-minded to experiment in the audition and interact with anyone reading with you.
- You may be asked to read the same scene multiple times to demonstrate your ability to take direction or experiment with characterisation.

We will personally contact every auditionee to inform them of our final decisions.

Expectations

Attendance at all program sessions is essential, and we encourage your child to participate enthusiastically and with a positive mindset. We are committed to maintaining a safe and enjoyable atmosphere where bullying and unsafe conduct are not permitted. Should such behaviour occur, it will be addressed with a warning, and any subsequent incidents will lead to appropriate measures being taken in collaboration with the child's parent/guardian.

Given the program's time constraints, children must learn **their lines before attending**. We encourage you to assist them in any way possible to ensure they are well-prepared and confident.



Children are required to bring a packed lunch, snacks, and a water bottle each day. Children will sign in/out each day. They are not permitted to leave the hall during the sessions.

Mobile phones must be left on silent and in bags until break times. Due to privacy reasons, videos and photos may not be taken during the program.

Schedule

The program runs daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Numurkah Town Hall. The hall will be open 15 minutes before and after each session, so parents/guardians can pick up their children. If you are going to be late, please get in touch with us ASAP.

As we would like to start and finish on time at each rehearsal, please arrive 10 minutes before commencement.

Due to a previous booking, the Town Hall will not be available on Tuesday, July 9th. On this day, the program will run from the Singer's Shed.
