Hula Scholarship Application Criteria for Children

You are applying for a Hula Scholarship through the hula school, Hula Hālau ‘Ohana Holo’oko’a, which is located in Beaverton, Oregon.

Eligibility Criteria

- The age of the student must be 3 through 17 years old.
- Oregon or SW Washington resident.
- Family income must be within the income eligibility guidelines set forth by the Federal Income Guidelines for free and reduced-price meals. Review qualifications for this program below.

Scholarship Information

- A full scholarship will be given to those who qualify for free meals.
- A 50% scholarship will be given to those who qualify for reduced price meals.
- The scholarship is good for a full year, February 6, 2022- February 4th, 2023 if the attendance guidelines are met. The student must attend at least 75% of current classes/sessions to retain the scholarship.
- KIAKO will pay the full uniform rental cost if the free meal income criteria are met and 50% if the reduced income criteria are met.
- For a full year scholarship, the below guidelines must be met.

- Your 2021 1040 (remove SSN#) must be submitted by April 15th. Family income must continue to be within the income eligibility guidelines set forth by the Federal Income Guidelines for free and reduced-price meals.
- KIAKO will pay for costumes if the free meal income criteria are met and the student attends at least 12 performances.
- KIAKO will pay 50% of costumes if the reduced income criteria are met and the student attends at least 12 performances.
- If the student does not attend at least 50% of the performances and does not meet the attendance guidelines, KIAKO will own the costumes.
- Student is expected to be on time for class & performances.
- Upon receipt of a full year hula scholarship, 15 hours of adult volunteer hours are required during the scholarship year.

Hula Scholarship Application Criteria for Children

This application must be received by **January 14, 2022** with your 2020 1040 (remove SSN#) to qualify for the 2022 full scholarship.

Your first 4 weeks will be a trial to confirm the hula class is a good fit for your keiki and the halau. Once approved you will receive the balance of the scholarship as long as the guidelines are maintained.
