



Place dry ice on top of items to be frozen with an insulating material between. If freezing trophy game, do not allow direct contact with trophy. Superficial or freezer burn damage may result.

Place dry ice in bottom of cooler, cover with insulating material, then place food, cans, etc. on top. Do not allow direct contact with dry ice.

Suggested uses and quantities:

Standard Cooler 5-7 lbs. per day (18-24 hrs) Fun Effects, 5-10 lbs. of dry ice + 4-8 gallons of hot water such as Foo Shipping 5-7 lbs. of dry ice will keep 2 lb. of frozen food cold for 24 hours DOT shipping regulations apply **Emergency** 1.5 lbs. per cubic ft. of refrigerator space (Power Outages)
