

## Confess To A Man, Or Directly to God?

Psalm 32:5 – This psalm says to confess your sins to the Lord Psalm 28:13 - If you confess your sins and repent, you prosper **Daniel 9:4-20** – Daniel confesses directly to God

Matthew 3:6 – John the Baptist's converts confess their sins out loud


