How do you launch a radio station without an FCC license? Well, the first step is to get your ducks in a row, make sure everything is working and then allow potential broadcast listeners to sample the new station with a live stream on the internet.

Once the final tweaking sessions are over, and the system is performing to perfection, we will launch the stream through the services of the StreamGuys in California. The broadcast studio needs a few more audio cables, adapters and monitors, but the basics are being assembled.

We'll start with the live morning show from 7 to 9 a.m. and add local praise teams, choirs and pastor's segments. Watch for the URL link!
