## New Broadcast Studio Nearly Complete.

Thanks to the diligence of Brian Witthoef, Taylor Fendley, Bruce McVaugh and many others, what was the darkroom at Alaska Bible Institute has been converted into the broadcast studio of KHCX.

The two-room suite will house KHCX, as well as provide programming for KAVM, the low-power FM station in Cold Bay and will be the origination site of the 12 translators around the state of Alaska from Dutch Harbor to Delta Junction. The translators carry 24 hour programming from the Moody Radio Network based in Chicago.

This project is the result of a partnership between Safe Harbor Broadcasting and Alaska Village Missions, the licensee of the Cold Bay Station and the Moody translators.

On December 20, 2021, Safe Harbor Broadcasting, based in Homer, Alaska, was granted a Construction Permit by the FCC to build a Class A, Non-Commercial Educational FM Station to serve Homer.

Work began immediately to build a broadcast studio in space donated by Alaska Bible Institute. In addition to donated studio space, Safe Harbor was also granted tower and transmitter site space by South Central Radar at the end of the Homer Spit.

By February, Safe Harbor had also acquired the call letters of KHCX, Homer's Christian Hit Radio.
