

WESTERN DRESSAGE ASSOCIATION OF NORTHERN ALBERTA ("WDANA")

BYLAWS

MEMBERSHIP:

1. Membership in WDANA is open to riders of all ages with the pre-requisite of a current membership in the Alberta Equestrian Federation (AEF).
2. Membership dues are paid annually based on a single or family membership.
3. Membership dues shall be determined by the membership at an Annual General Meeting,
4. Any member wishing to withdraw from membership may do so with notice in writing (includes e-mail) to the Executive through the Secretary. Any member, upon a majority vote of all members of WDANA in good standing, may be expelled from membership for any cause which the association deems reasonable.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS (EXECUTIVE)

1. Board of Directors shall man the Executive members of WDANA
2. The Executive shall consist of President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary and Directors at Large All members of the Executive are volunteers.
3. The term of office for each of the members of the Executive shall be two (2) years unless voted on to extend their term of office at an Annual General Meeting.
4. The Executive shall, subject to the By-laws or directions given it by a majority vote at any properly called and constituted meeting, have full control and management of the affairs of WDANA.
5. Meetings of the Executive shall be held as often as required. A special meeting may be called by any two (2) Executive members provided a written request if given to the President stating the business to be brought before the meeting.
6. Meetings of the Executive may be called with ten (10) day's notice given by e-mail, text or telephone.
7. Any three (3) members of the Executive shall constitute a quorum.
8. A meeting may be held without notice if a quorum of the Executive is present, provided however, any business transacted at such meeting must be ratified at the next regularly called meeting of the Executive. Failure to do so with render any such decisions null and void.
9. Any person appointed or elected becomes a director if they were at the meeting when appointed or elected and did not refuse the appointment. They may also become a director if they were not present at the meeting but consented, in writing, to act as a director before the election or appointment, or within ten (10) days after the election or appointment).
