PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING

1. Please read all rules and forms before completing the entry form.
2. Full entry fees must accompany all entries.
3. Entries must be complete and **include copies** of the following:
 - a) copy of lease agreement or contract of sale (if applicable)
 - b) copy of membership cards from WDANA & AEF for each owner, rider (WDANA membership ***is not required*** – however entries will cost a bit more for non-members)
 - c) Please provide a current email address on your entry form, as this is how we will send out Show information and ride times.
 - d) Parent/Guardian signature for Minors on all signature lines. No Minor Signatures!

ENTRY REGULATIONS

1. Entries must be received by May 29th with full payment. If you have requests for ride times, please include them on your entry form.
2. An entry is not considered valid until it has been paid in full. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. Cheques or money orders should be made out to WDANA. Electronic money transfer can be set to: info.wdana@gmail.com Password: Wdana01 (case sensitive)
3. All forms can be filled out, scanned and emailed to: info.wdana@gmail.com or mailed to:
 - a. Susan These - Box 79, Hay Lakes, AB T0B 1W0
4. All entries must have the signature of the owner or authorized agent and a signature for the person responsible for the horse.
5. You will not be allowed to ride without a person responsible signature on your entry form.
6. Junior riders must have permission to participate in the show as indicated by the signature of a parent or guardian. Junior must be under that age of 18 on June 10, 2018.
7. The organizing committee reserves the right to limit entries. Entries will be entered on a first come first serve basis. To Assure yourself of a place in the show, please get your entries in early!
8. There will be no refunds of entry fees after the official closing date except for a Veterinary or Doctor's Certificate.
9. A horse/rider combination may compete in only two consecutive levels and a maximum of 4 tests per day.
10. All tests will be ridden in the 20x60 ring size.
11. The administration fee will not be refunded. There will be no post entries.
12. There will be a concession stand offering snacks, a limited selection. Please bring your own lunch and refreshments.
13. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times when on the property and must be picked up after.
14. Test readers are permitted. The show committee will not provide test readers.

Protective Headgear

Article A905 states a) Junior competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on competition or event grounds

NEW – B1501.22 NEW for 2012

Dressage riders are subject to Dressage rule E4 Safety Headgear and must, regardless of age or level or competition wear ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN approved protective headgear

The person Responsible is the individual responsible and accountable for the care, training, custody and performance of the horse. The Person Responsible may be the trainer or maybe an owner, rider, driver, agent or coach. The Person Responsible must be an adult and in the case of junior entries, parents/guardian are entitled to sign their child's entry form without holding an EC Sport License -

AWARDS

1. Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place. Divisions will be Junior, Adult Amateur and Open.
2. Any horse receiving less than 50% of the total points obtainable in a test shall not be eligible for awards, ribbons or prizes.
3. When there is only one horse in a class, ribbons and prizes shall be awarded in accordance with the following chart of percentages:
 - a. 1st 60% or higher
 - b. 2nd 57% to 59.9%
 - c. 3rd 54% to 56.9%
 - d. 4th 51 to 53.9%
4. High Point Ribbons will be awarded at the end of the show for:
 - a. Junior High Score – highest single score achieved by a Junior rider.
 - b. Adult Amateur High Score – highest single score achieved by and AA rider.
 - c. Open High Score – highest single score achieved by an Open rider

Equitation Rail Classes

Western Equitation - To be shown at walk, jog and lope. Judged 40% on rider's position and seat, 40% on rider's correct and effective use of the aids and 20% on harmony between horse and rider

Equitation Rail Class Walk & Jog – Junior /Adult Amateur/Open
Equitation Rail Class Walk & Jog and Lope – Junior/ Adult Amateur/Open

There will be only two classes – all riders for the class will ride together.

WDANA SIGNATURE FORM

The following must be signed by ALL COMPETITORS. Entry will be considered invalid without all necessary signatures and dates.

“I hereby certify that every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representatives to be bound by the Constitution and Rules of WDAA at this competition. It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I hereby accept this risk and hold harmless WDAA, the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, employees and their representatives.”

In the event that _____ participates in a WDAA sanctioned competition where protective headgear is required for juniors, he/she will wear properly fitted and fastened approved headgear at all times while riding or driving at the event location. It is understood that juniors not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete at these competitions.” See Rules of Equine Canada, Section A, Article A905, Headgear.
