Thomas Seisay and Tony Seisay have been working alongside social work since 2014 as they have adopted two children, one from Scotland and one from England.
During this time, they have done extent training and workshops and created a very good knowledge of the care system.
After their involvement with the care system they decided, that more positive outcome could be given to care experienced young people.

Every Young person has the right to an education, we have witnessed first-hand the disadvantages care experienced young people face to attaining this basic right! With first-hand knowledge of the Care system and impact on our children's lives we couldn't sit back and let it continue.

29% of school leavers who in care during 2020/21 were not in further or higher education, employment, or training 9 months after leaving school, compared to 7% of all school leavers.

Care experienced young people are more than 6 times more likely to be excluded from school than their peers.





Haus of Seisay is a charitable enterprise founded in 2022. Its direct purpose is to provide opportunities for care experienced young people to gain a set of skills and tangible experience to enable them to improve their prospects.

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Irradicating Stigma and supporting positive outcomes for Care experienced young people. Haus of Seisay's vision is to equalise opportunities for Care experienced young people, elevating these young people in line with their peers. We aim to be industry leading in development of care experienced young people and the alternative educational choices provided to them. The aim of the organisation is to provide a community led initiative that aims to support care experienced young people by providing opportunities within the Haus of Seisay Hairdressing Academy, which will improve life opportunities for the young person and also strengthen resilience within our communities.

The initiative allows care experienced young people, who are very often dealing with a variety of complex needs when making the transition to leave the care setting

(social isolation, addiction, bereavement, loneliness, mental health issues and trauma) with a range of practical and therapeutic activities/ life skills that will facilitate a positive outcome to enable them to move on with their lives.

Whilst the primary focus is within a salon environment, a holistic approach to meet the young person's needs will include health and well-being activities, training, peer mentoring, volunteering opportunities and work experience (both hairdressing and other areas such as admin, book keeping, business). These activities, provided by an experienced/ trained individuals with peer support, will alleviate the social isolation and loneliness many care experienced feel through not having the support of the family environment.

Funding would allow care experience young people to obtain the confidence and skills required to be supported within a nurturing environment, whilst reducing social isolation they may be experiencing through building and maintaining positive relationships, which will contribute to their self-worth/value, and help them be better connected to their communities.
