Rail Vikas Nigam Limited (RVNL) granted Navratna Status

Rail Vikas Nigam Limited (RVNL), a Central Public Sector Enterprises of Ministry of Railways, has been granted Navratna Status.

RVNL was incorporated as PSU on 24th January, 2003, with the twin objectives of implementation of projects relating to creation and augmentation of capacities of rail infrastructure on fast track basis and raising of extra budgetary resources for SPV projects. The company began its operation in 2005 with the appointment of Board of Directors. The company was granted Mini-Ratna status in September 2013. The authorized share capital of the company is Rs. 3000 Crore, with paid up share capital of Rs. 2085 crore.

RVNL has been assigned the following functions:

- i. Undertaking project development and execution of works covering full project life cycle.
- ii. Creating Project specific SPVs for individual works, if required
- iii. On completion of a Railway project by RVNL, the concerned Zonal Railway will undertake its operation and maintenance

The grant of "Navratna" status to RVNL leads to enhanced delegation of powers, more operational freedom and financial autonomy which will give huge impetus to RVNL's progress, particularly so, when RVNL is extending its footprints in sectors beyond Railways and even in

On April 26, 2023 Hon'ble Finance Minister approved the upgradation of RVNL to Navratna CPSE from a Miniratna. RVNL has now become the 13th Navratna amongst the CPSEs. Having Navratna Status opens a pathway for RVNL to acquire assets in different foreign countries, which is extremely advantageous as it aids SPV formation out of the country. It also offers us greater flexibility from an HR perspective.

Our current SPV interest rate stands at 8.5%, RVNL has adopted the HAM model which will be much more favorable to the cost efficiency of our upcoming SPVs.

As RVNL has come up L1 in Chennai metro Project we are now conducting metro project in 3 major cities in INDIA - Surat , Indore & Chennai. The company's prime focus remains on inviting more challenging metro project in India as well as abroad as we are conducting 3 underground station in the chennai metro project, which is a new field for RVNL.

If we are to talk about the financial terms of the company, the CAGR of 27% growing is possible in the next few years. RVNL projects were earlier dependent on the nominations of metro railway;



however, now as we bid in an open market, new opportunities open up. CMD concludes by giving a strong standing point of RVNL saying that RVNL has the technical and managerial strength for ensuring project efficiency and delivery on time.





FOB commissioned at Salpura station of Kota - Bina doubling project

hecommissioning of a FOB (Foot Over Bridge) has been completed at Salpura station in the Kota-Bina doubling Project under PIU-I of Kota. The project was sanctioned in 2011-12 and the total length of the project is 288.236 km, with 148.87 km in Rajasthan and 139.36 km in Madhya Pradesh. The project includes 32 major bridges, 202 minor bridges, 4 RUBs (Road Under Bridges), and 43 level crossings. There are a total of 36 stations in the project. The completion of the Kota-Bina Doubling Project will improve connectivity towards the cities of Kota, Baran, Guna, Ashoknagar & Bina. The route is an important and busy section of the West Central



Railway with more than 23 Mail/Express Trains operating on this section along with 42 Goods trains, and a sectional capacity utilization of 106.60%.

The project, which was sanctioned in 2011-12, involved the construction of a second line with a sectional speed of 110 kmph. This increase in capacity would allow for more trains to operate on the route, meeting the growing demand for passenger and goods traffic. Additionally, the project would improve punctuality and reduce congestion on the rail route. It would also enhance the handling of coal transportation for thermal plants and fertilizer plants along the route. Furthermore, the project would boost connectivity to major pilgrimage sites and facilitate faster movement of agricultural and local products. The benefits of the Kota-Bina doubling project in the West Central Railway include improving connectivity to cities such as Kota, Baran, Guna, Ashoknagar, and Bina. It will also attract investments for other industries and create employment opportunities in the region. The project will lead to social and economic development in the districts of Kota, Baran, Guna, Ashoknagar, and Sagar. All 15 sections of the project have been commissioned after CRS inspections, with maximum speeds ranging from 90kmph to 110kmph. The project was completed within the target.

he construction work of a new foot overbridge (FOB) at Bhulon station is currently underway as part of the Kota-Bina doubling project under PIU-I. This FOB, once completed, will serve as a vital link between Platform No. 1 and Platform No. 2 of Maban station. The project aims to enhance connectivity and improve the overall infrastructure of the railway network in the area. The girder launching process for the FOB at Bhulon station is a crucial step in its construction, ensuring that the bridge is solidly anchored and capable of safely accommodating pedestrian traffic between the two platforms. The authorities are dedicatedly working towards the successful completion of the project to provide a seamless travel experience for passengers using the Kota-Bina route.

Br.no 134 Pier protection work which was badly erroded and exposed Pier foundation due to flood.







uring a period of heavy rainfall, Bridge number 134 faced significant erosion and damage to its pier foundation. The constant downpour caused severe scouring around the pier, eventually exposing its foundation. To address this issue and safeguard the stability of the pier, protective measures were taken. A Gavion

Pitching system, combined with concrete-cement (CC) material, was meticulously placed around the pier. This approach successfully mitigated the effects of the flood and secured the integrity of the bridge structure. These essential pier protection works were completed in June 2023, ensuring the bridge's longevity and continued safe usage.



500m Central drain constructed at Bina end on high embankment between UP & DN Main Line of Br 134 and Toe wall with CC block pitching 425m.

500-meter central drain has been constructed at the Bina end, situated on a high embankment between the UP and DN Main Lines of Bridge 134. The purpose of this construction is to effectively drain out any water logging that may occur between the UP and DN tracks. Recognizing the importance of this issue, it was decided to contract the building of the central drain at Bridge 134. Currently, the construction of the central drain is still in progress at the mentioned bridge. In addition to the central drain, a 425-meter toe wall with CC block pitching has also been completed at Bridge 134. However, due to the combination of a high bank and heavy rainfall, the bank slope has been washed out. Authorities from the railway department visited the site and have instructed the protection of the toe wall with CC Block Pitching as a measure to safeguard the embankment from any further erosion or damage caused by the existing conditions.










Jatdumri-Daniawan New B.G.Line (23.8 Km) in Danapur Division under ECR

new Railway Line has been commissioned in the Jatdumri-Daniawan area under the East Central Railway (ECR) division. The line spans 23.8 kilometers and features a new Road Over Bridge (ROB) over State Highway-1. The ROB has four lanes and a span of 174 meters. The approach road is 604 meters long and the overall length of the ROB is 778 meters. The project cost is approximately 91 crores. Traffic on the ROB was opened on May 8, 2023.









Longest girder (50 Mtr. span) in place for Joka Metro Erection of 50m Plate Girder Span at Majerhat on Diamond Harbour Road at Burdwan Crossing



OKA- Khidirpur section of JOKA-Esplanade Metro runs along the median of extremely busy Diamond Harbour Road. There was a big challenge to launch the 50m span on this road at the T-junction called Burdwan crossing. To accomplish this feat, two road-mounted cranes - one weighing 250 tonnes and another weighing 150 tonnes - were utilized, with an additional 300-tonne crane on standby.









new central panel building at Raipur (Jn) has been commissioned in connection with the Raipur-Titlagarh section. The Raipur-Titlagarh Doubling project, which spans 203 km, has been fully commissioned with the completion of the last RVH-Raipur section. This project is considered super critical and will improve port connectivity, facilitate the transportation of coal, and enhance the socio-economic development of Odisha, Chhattisgarh, and Madhya Pradesh. The Raipur-RVH section, which is 3 km long, was successfully commissioned on May 10th, 2023. The project included the construction of three minor bridges and a panel building with the remodeling of RVH and Raipur yards. This section marks the completion of the entire Raipur-Titlagarh doubling project.



Yard remodelling of Nishatpura (Bina-HBJ)

he yard remodelling project at Nishatpura (Bina-HBJ) was successfully completed on May 3, 2023. This has been achieved after insertion of 8 new crossovers to facilitate bi-directional movement of the middle line between BPL-SUW, creating provision for a common loop at NSZ for increased operational efficiency, construction of 2 new platforms to handle passenger traffic, installation of a new Siemens SSI system with a total of 276 routes, including 160 main signal routes and 116 shunt signal routes. In addition,





there are a total of 42 main signals, 17 independent shunt signals, and 30 dependent shunt signals. The track circuit configuration includes 67 conventional circuits and 19 axle counter MSDACs. This commissioning also involved making the middle line suitable for DN direction traffic from BPL to SUW (covering a distance of 12 km).

Tunnel no. 08 works completed at BHOPAL site

he tunnel works at PIU Bhopal have been successfully completed. This includes the completion of the lining and BLT in all eight tunnels of the BNI-BKA 3rd line project, consisting





of three cut and cover tunnels and five conventional tunnels. This accomplishment marks a significant milestone in reaching our goal of completing this crucial 3rd line project by October 2023.



New Cansaulim Station Building in Part of Doubling Project between Madgaon to Vasco, Goa



plinth area of 210 square meters, the building offers ample space for various purposes. Special attention has been given to inclusivity with the provision of a dedicated pathway ramp for differently abled individuals. The construction of

new station building has been constructed at Cansaulim station in Goa as part of the ongoing doubling project between Madgaon and Vasco. This new building replaces the existing old structure, which was built way back in 1891. The design of the new station building is based on traditional Goan architectural style, giving it a unique and local touch. With a

the new station building, which includes a ground floor and first floor with stilt parking spaces, was completed within a timeframe of 1 year and 5 months. The commissioning of this modern facility took place in April 2023 along with stage 1 commissioning of Cansaulim yard. We are proud to present this state-of-the-art infrastructure to serve commuters in Goa.

Bow String Girder launched for ROB at Kalem yard

In the month of May 2023, a 36-meter long Bow String Girder was launched for the construction of a Road Overbridge (ROB) at the Kalem yard in Goa. This project, located at CH:59/770, is set to connect the villages of Kalem and Sanvordem in the South Goa district. This ROB will serve as a crucial link for the major district road, facilitating smoother transportation and connectivity for the residents of these two villages. The launch of the Bow String Girder marks a significant milestone in the construction of this essential infrastructure project, bringing it one step closer to completion and ensuring enhanced accessibility for the local community.





Progress updates on Mathura-Jhansi 3rd Line Project









he proposed alignment of the 3rd line in the Datia-Sonagir section of the Mathura-Jhansi 3rd line project involves crossing the UP line near an existing ROR with a bank height of 6m. Due to safety concerns of running trains and the need to avoid speed restrictions, it was not feasible to construct a bridge on the existing UP line. Therefore, we proposed using a RCC box size of 1/9x8.5m with a barrel length of 16m, utilizing the pushing method and launching an RH Girder with a span of 28m. This was a critical task for commissioning the Datia-Dabra section of the Mathura-Jhansi 3rd line project, and it was successfully completed in May/June 2023.

In addition, at KM 1158, there was approximately 300m of hard rock on both sides of the DN main line where the proposed 3rd line alignment was

parallel to DN mainline at track center 8m. To create the foundation for the proposed line, it was necessary to cut through this rock formation. This activity was executed safely under power and traffic block without any speed restrictions on DN track, ensuring both track safety and proper preparation for future work.
