Pre-KG / Play Group

The pre-KG/playgroup programme provides a structured day with a choice of learning opportunities - arts, crafts, construction activities, table top games, stories, rhymes, music and much more. We will introduce early numeracy and literacy skills and activities designed to develop your child's communication skills.

LKG and UKG

Our kindergarten programme is based on our experience with the uniquness in learning and developent of every child.

By combining this knowledge with the goals of the Early Years Foundation Framework and guidance from CBSE/ICSE curriculum, the Magic Stars team plan appropriate learning experiences that will give each child the opportunity to reach his/her full potential.

Goals and Objectives

- Learn how to work, play, cooperate with others and function in a group beyond the family.
- Develop competence in speaking, listening, reading and writing in english.
- Understand and record numbers, and show awareness of number operations, such as addition and subtraction and beginning to use the language involved.
- Explore and recognize events, features in the natural and man-made world and look closely at similarities, differences, patterns and changes.
- Develop physical control, mobility, spatial awareness and manipulative skills in indoor and outdoor environments.
- Develop children's imagination and their ability to communicate, express ideas and feelings in creative ways.

Activity based learning will be a predominant way for children to learn and achieve the goals and objectives, but at the same time our programme is guided by CBSE/ICSE curriculum, which will give your child a smooth transition to primary school.

Asessment

Evaluation is a continuous process and will go on throughout the year. The assessment is not exam based but an eval-

uation of what skills the children are acquiring and relating to what they are learning. The evaluation is about the children's work rather than their ability to perform under exam conditions. Steps can be taken promptly to





address any gaps in the learning, without making the children conscious of it.

It is never too early to join Magic Stars. Children could start as early as 22months. We believe that children learn

We do not close for summer as we believe continuity is crucial for the child's development. During summer we run our own summer programme for children up to 12 years.

Sessions: Morning -9.00am to 12noon

Afternoon -1.00pm to 3.00pm (for LKG & UKG)

For the welfare of the children, it is necessary to maintain school timings, unless prior arrangement has been made for a late drop off or late pick-up.

Children can be dropped off 15mins before start of the session and to be collected at close of the session or within 30mins after the session.

Fees: Paid quarterly in advance.

Hygiene and Safety

Magic Stars maintains a high standard of cleanliness to pro-

vide a safe and healthy environment for your child. There is a regular routine of washing hands, particularly before and after snack and also after any messy play activity. Children are encouraged to take pride in their own

school.





To develop positive social skills in children, we have routine practice of ensuring children have good table manners, putting things back in their place after they finish working with it, and keeping their school clean and tidy.

We take safety of children very seriously. Our gates are kept locked after 9.30am and will be opened at close of session.

Children who are likely to be picked up by 3rd party, will require ID proof, which Magic Stars can arrange on request.


