Harrison County Agri-Business Association Scholarship Application Criteria

The Harrison County Agri-Business Association's Scholarship shall be awarded to a deserving youth who has been actively involved in 4-H and/or FFA programs and who has demonstrated the interests and ability to pursue an education at the college level.

1. Students must be a member in good standing of a Harrison County FFA chapter or 4-H club, and need not be entered in the Farm City Week Livestock Show. Eligibility must conform to rule #3 of the FCW General Rules updated 6/21.
2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior (with a "B" average) and must have participated in FFA or 4-H for at least two years.
3. Applicant must have exhibited at the Harrison County Farm City Week Show at least twice during high school years.
4. Applicant must submit a completed scholarship application form to the Scholarship Selection Committee. All required documents must arrive with the application. These documents include: completed application; high school transcript; official SAT/ACT Score(s); additional pages as needed to complete replies to application questions; and letter(s) of recommendation from teacher, FFA advisor or 4-H leader.
5. Applications must be postmarked on or before the first Monday of March.
6. The scholarship award will be paid directly to the college after recipient has completed registration at an accredited two-year or four-year college. Recipient is required to attend college the fall semester immediately following selection.
7. Selection will be based on scholarship, leadership, citizenship, and participation in 4-H and FFA programs.
8. Scholarship recipients will be announced at the FCW Auction Thursday evening at 5:30 pm (at the Marshall Arena).
9. Applicants are eligible for one (1) scholarship awarded by the Harrison County Agri-Business Association Scholarship Selection Committee in the same year. This includes the Harrison County Agri-Business Association Scholarship, Mike Emery Memorial Scholarship, Tony Whitlow Memorial Scholarship, Jack Dillard Sr., and any other related FCW scholarships.
