Harrison County Agri-Business Association Scholarship Application Criteria

The Harrison County Agri-Business Association's Scholarship shall be awarded to a deserving youth who has been actively involved in 4-H and/or FFA programs and who has demonstrated the interests and ability to pursue an education at the college level.

- 1. Students must be a member in good standing of a Harrison County FFA chapter or 4-H club, and need not be entered in the Farm City Week Livestock Show. Eligibility must conform to rule #3 of the FCW General Rules updated 6/21.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior (with a "B" average) and must have participated in FFA or 4-H for at least two years.
- 3. Applicant must have exhibited at the Harrison County Farm City Week Show at least twice during high school years.
- 4. Applicant must submit a completed scholarship application form to the Scholarship Selection Committee. All required documents must arrive with the application. These documents include: completed application; high school transcript; official SAT/ACT Score(s); additional pages as needed to complete replies to application questions; and letter(s) of recommendation from teacher, FFA advisor or 4-H leader.
- 5. Applications must be postmarked on or before the first Monday of March.
- 6. The scholarship award will be paid directly to the college after recipient has completed registration at an accredited two-year or four-year college. Recipient is required to attend college the fall semester immediately following selection.
- 7. Selection will be based on scholarship, leadership, citizenship, and participation in 4-H and FFA programs.
- 8. Scholarship recipients will be announced at the Hamburger Kickoff Dinner on Monday, March 20, 2023 at 6:00 pm (at the Marshall Arena).
- 9. Applicants are eligible for one (1) scholarship awarded by the Harrison County Agri-Business Association Scholarship Selection Committee in the same year. This includes the Harrison County Agri-Business Association Scholarship, Mike Emery Memorial Scholarship, Jon Michael Nash Memorial Scholarships, and any other related FCW scholarships.
