

Classical Music Meets Modern Lighting, Awakening Infinite Imagination Tingting Wu's Dreamy Piano Concert, ColorMusic Intertwined with Stories

Music nurtures the soul, heals the heart, and soothes the mind. Classical music, timeless and ever-inspiring, is cherished across generations.

On Friday, December 27, pianist Tingting Wu hosted a unique piano concert, ColorMusic, at the ColorMusic Hall in Brickell, Miami. The performance featured 10 segments, showcasing classical masterpieces by Chopin, Beethoven, Debussy, Liszt, Schumann, and Rachmaninoff.

Tingting Wu, originally from Shenyang, China, earned her Doctor of Musical Arts (DMA) degree in Piano Performance from the University of Miami in May 2023 with a full scholarship. In 2022, she was invited by Grammy and Emmy Award-winning conductor Gerard Schwarz to participate in the production of the U.S. PBS music program, Pictures at an Exhibition, where she performed a 15-minute piano solo. The program has since aired on over 220 PBS stations across the United States.

Tingting Wu is the founder of the ColorMusic project, which aims to merge modern lighting art with classical music through a unique musical concept, creating an immersive experience for audiences. With ColorMusic, she seeks to redefine the expression of classical music, offering audiences a unique and captivating musical journey.

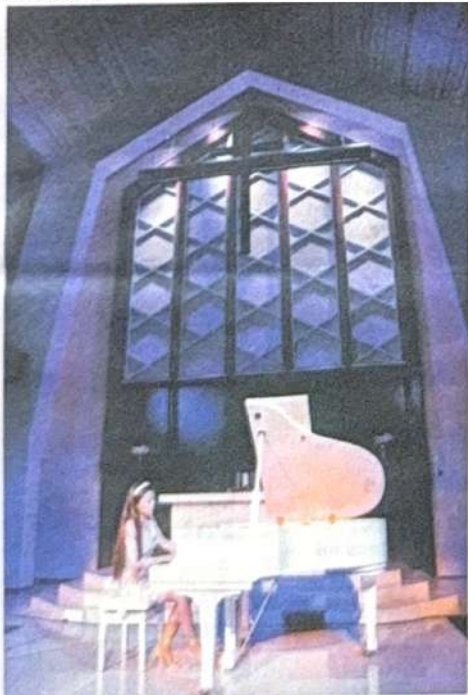
During the concert, before each piece, Tingting Wu introduced the music through storytelling, describing its emotions and atmosphere to help the audience connect with the feelings behind the composition. She then used dynamic stage lighting effects during her performance to enhance the audience's immersion in the emotional journey of the music.

During the final bow, Tingting Wu gave special recognition to her concert partner, Dr. Guillermo Ospina. A Doctor of Percussion from the University of Miami and a talented percussionist, Dr. Ospina frequently explores innovative lighting techniques to support artistic performances. For this concert, he assisted Tingting Wu in bringing her colored lighting concepts to life, helping to realize her vision for the evening's immersive experience.
