Walking Trails

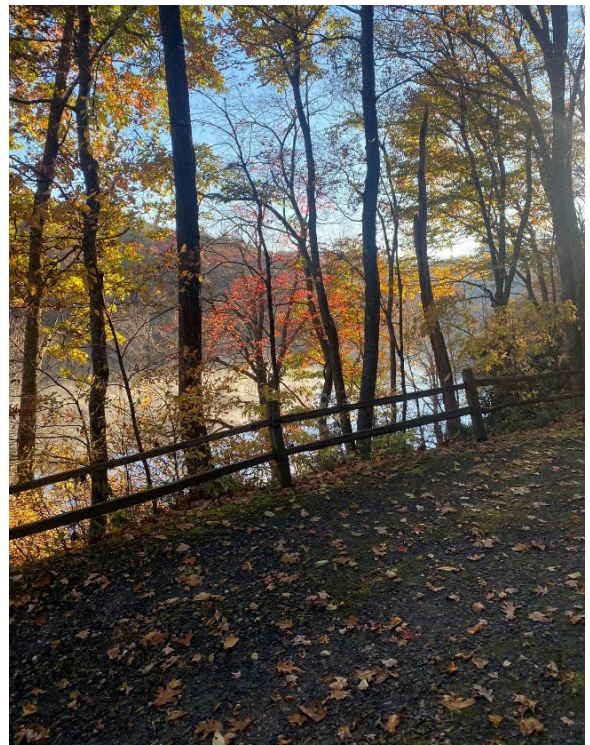
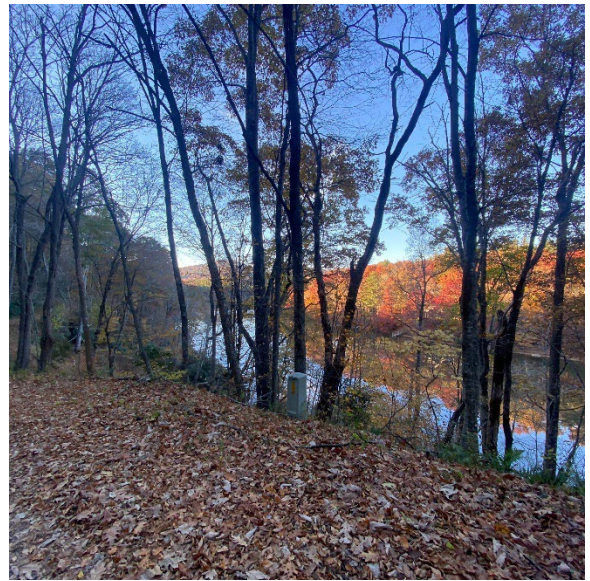
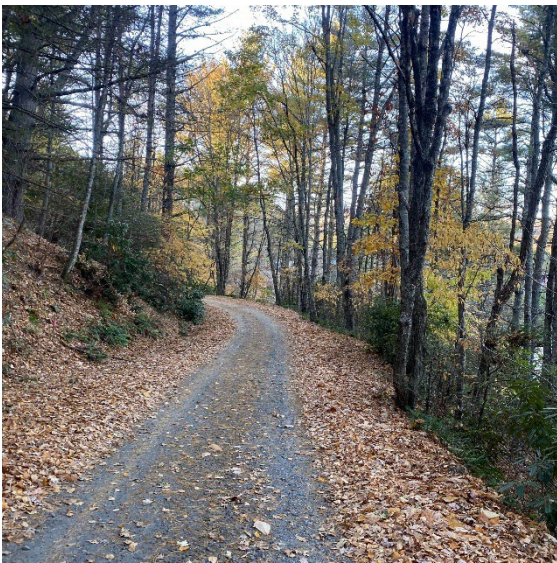
