Dec. 10, 1915 - One millionth Ford produced

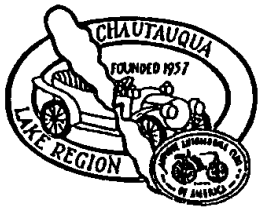
Dec. 10, 1970 – Lee Iacocca named President of Ford
