



Interview with ...

Sumi Rain



How did you get into the game?

My daughter Miss Sarah got me started about six years ago. It was our way of connecting because I worked a 72-hour week back then. And I was never really home.

What's your favorite part about the game? And what keeps you playing, is it still mostly a way of connecting for you both?

I like gathering for the most part, and helping the FC family to achieve success. In a way, the FC is my second family. I was very lucky when Istari recruited me. I was about to quit playing. But instead I found a home. Also I got lucky because I've had a lot of very good mentors since I joined. I really don't know how to express my gratitude for everyone that has helped me out.

The people we meet along the way definitely play a huge part in what keeps us going, we are all very fortunate to have you with us.

No, I'm just Sumi. Anyone can be someone who just wants everyone to be happy. Maybe it's because I see everyone like I see my grandchildren. After all, I think I'm the oldest in the FC.

From one map enthusiast to another, would you say that's the big reason you got into map gathering?

Yes, most definitely. I had a lot of people ask me why I donate all the maps I do and not just sell them. It's my way of helping everyone out. I enjoy hearing about the fun everyone has running them, and how they make gil to buy what they otherwise wouldn't be able to afford.

That's a big part of why I have done my best to host the map nights every week, and I can easily say your contribution to making it all possible is far beyond greatly appreciated. It certainly makes a lot of people happy!

Thank you for helping everyone out by running them.

Do you have a favorite combat job and/or a favorite non-combat job?

I would say Bard and Samurai. I just started taking up crafting and having fun with it. I also like Dark Knight, but I'm not really a magic person, even though I have classes up to LVL80.

So we noticed you lead the 'Java Club' in the FC, can you tell us more about it?

The Java Club was just all the early risers in the FC--as far as the "leader," I'm not too sure about that. Kai thought of the name and everyone just ran with it. It's mainly just us checking in on each other.

It's definitely something a lot of people enjoy, even just a simple thing can make a big difference to someone's day.

Yes and if someone is missing, a lot of times I will DM them to see if they are OK. And I'm sure other members do also.

That certainly helps keep that close-knit feeling like a family

If you think about it, the FC is one big family.

There have been a lot of expansions in the game so far. Is there one in particular you'd say is your favorite?

I would say Heavensward and then Shadowbringers. I thought the story in Heavensward was great. The problem with A Realm Reborn was that it was changing all the time, but they were trying to fix it.

Do you have a favorite NPC?

I like Cid because I can relate because of my job.

What is it you do if you don't mind telling the people?

I make beer and soda pop cans. 12oz or 355 mL. We have made a lot of collectable cans over the years. We're on track to make just a little over 2.2 billion this year and that is just from my place of work. We make about 6.2 million a day.

Going back to the game for a bit: your character name, how did you come up with it, is there a special meaning behind it?

The first FC I belonged to, the co-leader's name was Itsumi, and they were always very nice to me. So I shortened it to Sumi and I've always loved it when it was raining. So that's how I came up with Sumi Rain. I know it sounds corny, but that's how I got it.

Do you have a favorite mount and/or minion in the game?

My Black Hayate minion, because it reminds me of my Shiba Inu, Miss Rigby. I like the Ixion mount for show and normally I just ride my chocobo, who I named Sunny.

You mentioned Miss Rigby, how many pets do you have and what are their names?

I have two dogs, Miss Rigby and Father Mckenzie. Miss Rigby is a Black and Tan, he's a red Shiba Inu. I just got him September 2nd to give Miss Rigby a playmate. My daughter got a Samoyed puppy about two weeks earlier and we puppysit him. His name is Lupin.

With the coming of the next expansion Endwalker, what's one thing you're looking forward to most once it finally arrives?

I think the new jobs, Reaper and Sage, are going to be something to look at. I would like to see Square-Enix make Blue Mage a real job on its own, and I also want to see the new gear designs.

Are there any other games you play outside of FFXIV?

I used to play Assassin's Creed all the time, but haven't played in a while, because it seemed like they were just dumping the games on the market and they were not ready. Way too many patches.

How about some hobbies outside of gaming? What do you like to do?

I have a 1986 Toyota MR2 that we take Solo 2 running and I like running rallies. Cars were my first love back in the day.

Do you have any shows you like watching, or music you particularly enjoy?

I like watching a lot of Murdoch Mysteries and Blacklist. As far as music, I listen to classical, 60's, and 70's music.

What's one awesome fact about yourself that you'd like to share?

Well I'm 67 and plan on retiring soon. I've been lucky that I've done the same job for 47, almost 48 years. When the Misses found out she had cancer everyone always asked me how she was doing and that meant a lot to me.



All right, I'm going to probably make you sad, just a bit, ready? The game is coming to an end, you have thirty minutes to an hour to do one last thing, what would it be?

Probably try to contact everyone who has helped along the way in the game and thank them for doing so. I know that sounds crazy but if it wasn't for them I wouldn't be where I am today. I would tell them how much their support meant to me.

I probably would reach out to Istari for giving me a home and family and friends to game with; Golden Aida for my house and teaching me how to gather; James for just being a great friend, and helping me learn how to craft; a lot of others who no longer play all the time; good friends who left Waltz to start their own FCs; and friends who couldn't find a home like I have. Just to say "thank you" for being my friend.

As well as all the ones that I recruited for the FC and tell them how proud I am of them. It would be like saying goodbye to family.





The very last question I have for you tonight is a simple one. What is a quote you live by?

I try to treat people the way I want to be treated.

A classic one I feel, and a very true one at that. Now, it's time to collect maps.

Eorzean Chronicles A deeper look into the lore of FFXIV

10: Garlemald: The Birth of an Empire

The origins of the Garlean people is one shrouded in myth and mystery. Originally established by seven tribes, the largest contingency of 'pure blooded' Garleans are thought to be the remnants of a peoples who migrated from a city heretofore thought to be a legend.

Though many of the details are still hidden in an air of secrecy, it is believed, especially in certain artistic and academic circles, that the Garlean people were descended from the displaced citizens of Goug. After an explosion of unknown origin ruined half the city and resulted in its abandonment, the ancestors of the Garlean people were thought to have migrated to the southern regions of Ilsabard; a continent of extreme temperatures positioned between Aldenard and Othard.

Conventional histories in Garlemald and among the imperial strongholds begin here; teaching that the forebears of pure blooded Garleans were once comprised of several tribes of humble farmers. These tillers of the land made their homes in southern Ilsabard until they were driven from their verdant homeland by invaders wielding magicks that the Garleans were unable to combat, due to the absence of hereditary traits that allowed for the manipulation of aether.

Driven further and further into the northern mountains of Ilsabard, the early Garleans were forced to endure some of the harshest environments on Hydaelyn. With the Northern Seas frozen over for most of the year, and unforgiving storms that ravaged the coastal communities in the summer months, access to water was only available in slim windows. Cultivation and harvesting periods were also uncommonly short; making the common occupational choice of early Garleans, farming, a near impossibility.

By the year 922 of the Sixth Astral Era, many of the smaller villages of Garlean people had banded together around a central town. Others were brought in by negotiation or force, and eventually the Garlemald Republic was created, in order to unite its people against foreign aggression.

Even in the remote northern reaches of the Ilsabard mountain ranges, Hyur invaders from the north sought to take advantage of the magically disinclined peoples, and, through strength of arms, steal what they had eked out in their unforgiving environment. In retaliation, the Garleans turned to their own above average physical prowess, penchant for spycraft, and spacial awareness; made more prominent by their third eye, as well as the employ of Roegadyn magi from the central mountain regions. A certain subsect of particularly daring Garleans also sought to supplement their natural inability to channel aether by making pacts with the creatures of the void; taking to instruments once used solely for working the land, and turning them outward to 'reap a crimson harvest'.


Such was the way of life for the staunch Garlean survivors until the discovery of ceruleum, which would change every aspect of the Garlean way of life, and set their path upon the stage of world conquest. The vast deposits of the liquid blue substance burned as oil, and was initially used as such; keeping hearths warm in the cold winter months. However, at the turn of the 16th century, an engineer, attempting to create a smaller version of the stationary steam engine, stumbled upon the idea of using ceruleum as a fuel itself rather than a catalyst to heat water into steam.



As if by fate, this discovery caught the attention of then Legatus Solus van Galvus, who made his insistence that the military fund this new technology. The possibilities, he said, were 'endless'. With military support, the first ceruleum powered engine was built. These original prototypes were named 'Magitek' and before long, a full arsenal of such weapons were constructed to signify the military might of Garlemald, and its triumph over magic.

Any initial skepticism to Galvus' plans quickly faltered as neighboring nations began to fall to Garlemald's military might and warmachina. From 1515 to 1522, the Garleans invaded their neighbors in northern Ilsabard with abandon; annexing their lands. In order to grow its military might, Garlemald recruited the peoples of these lands, promising a better life through technology in return for service.

For his toils, the Garlean people regarded Galvus with a reverence bordering worship. In 1517 he was named dictator of Garlemald by popular support, and thus did Garlemald turn to conquer the south of Ilsabard, culminating to a full success in 1522. Having unified the continent, Galvus proclaimed himself Emperor Solus zos Galvus, and the Garlean Empire was born.


