Interview with . . .

Moon' Moon



How did you get into the game?

I first got into the game on the referral of one of my close friends IRL. He got me to play during the free trial and I ended up just going hard every day doing the story and exploring. I am previously a fan of the Final Fantasy franchise, so that helped with the allure of the story for myself. Always been into the fantastical genre of games, especially ones with a large environment. I'm a sucker for the exploration factor as well!

What is your favorite part of the game?

I would say the socialization aspect is the biggest factor because every day is different. It always feels like a new day logging on and there's always someone new to talk to as well as a wide range of activities to explore. Personally, I haven't even tried out a good percentage of the content in the game and I am slowly getting around to it. I think Waltz has been a huge factor to me as well in the part that keeps me playing because it feels nice to log on to a community you're so integrated with, who will always greet you and call out to you. I have made many friends in the game, so I don't think I could ever step away for too long.

Waltz really is a big factor in how someone views the game!What is your favorite battle class and your favorite non-battle class?

It would be a toss up between Black Mage and Bard, mainly because I played through all of the story with Black Mage when I first started, so it holds a special place in my heart; Bard because I always liked leaning more towards team support rather than just a DPS pump. For my favorite non-battle class, I would say Culinarian; I am an Omnicrafter, but I spend a large amount of time on Culinarian playing with the market, although I have been really into Weaver making clothes for people lately as well, crafting in general is just big fun!

Which expansion has been your favorite?

Heavensward, hands down. Not only do I really enjoy the story, but the music really makes it for me in a sense where the music tells a story as well. There are a lot of memorable characters from that expansion and I love the zones. I really like a steampunk art style when playing games so some of the zones really fit that style. It's an expansion that catches the eye and captures the memory.

Who is your favorite NPC(s)?

Oh god, my favorite NPC would have to be Alphinaud. He just resembles your best friend in the story and he gives me the kind of vibes where Alphy and I could just set up on LAN and be gaming buddies IRL. Just never seems to be a dull moment with him. People who have been playing since A Realm Reborn grew up with Alphinaud. He's just a brother in arms to me.

What's one thing you're looking forward to most in the coming patches?

I am excited to explore more on the Island Sanctuaries, I think the concept art for it was really compelling and it caught many eyes so I am really interested in learning more about that. I feel like that will add another layer to the socialization aspect of the game and that, for me, creates even more opportunities to meet new people and make friends!

Do you have a background to your character's name?

Honestly, this is a question I get a lot with the name "Moon" and I never know if I have an actual answer for it. I'm not a huge fan of astronomy or anything like that, but I always really liked the night sky and the moon. I think it's cool that even in the dark, there's something to light the way.

Iin Japanese mythology, Tsukuyomi-no-Mikoto is the god of the moon and their parent(s) are Izanagi and Izanami, both gods of creation and death. Tsukuyomi's siblings are also Amaterasu, who is the Goddess of the sun and universe, and Susanoo-no-Mikoto who is the god of the storm and the sea. And in different variations of pronunciation, parts of "Tsukuyomi" means moonlit night. My favorite part of that is being able to have light in the dark. So I named myself Moon in accordance with that; I'm just like many people and I aim to be that light for those who reside in the dark. For everyone who has wanted to know what the meaning behind my name has meant, that's how I view it!

What is your favorite mount and minion?

I would have to say my favorite mount is the Ironfrog Mover currently, because I like how Lalafells look on it, although I can't wait for them to release the MegaShiba! I just like mounts that shrink down for the lala size because it looks really cute! As for my favorite minion, surprisingly it is not the Moon minion, but the Plush Cushion minion because I like being comfy everywhere.

What is your favorite hangout spot in the game?

I have personal hangout spots that overlook the lady pouring water into the sea in Old Sharlayan, but you can mainly find me sitting on top of the chocobo stable in our FC yard. I like spending time at the house and in Ishgard in general, of course!

What other games do you play outside of FFXIV?

Currently, I have been playing a lot of Apex Legends and Dead By Daylight, but I enjoy playing Lost Ark and Tiny Tina's Wonderlands. I plan to start V-Rising soon as well. I am really into fast paced, heart racing games that get your adrenaline pumping. Love the movement, communication, and fun of playing against people who are always going to be better or equally as good as you!

What hobbies do you have outside of gaming?

I mention food a lot in FC chat, and I really enjoy cooking things on my griddle, smoker, grill, and pizza oven. I also maintain an awesome garden so that's very fun to me. On top of that, I love spending time and talking with three of my best friends. We do a lot together and every minute is worth it to me especially in a life I only live once.



Are there any shows/films or songs you would recommend?

Oh you know I like anime and my Discord profile is an anime character so I would say WATCH DEMON SLAYER, and I really advocate people to watch Haikyu! If you don't like volleyball, I promise you will be cheering at multiple points in this anime.

I have a very out there style of music such as a lot of hip hop, I would say my favorite song right now is "Father Stretch My Hands Pt. 1" by Kanye West. I don't watch many films either, but my all time favorite movie is Princess Mononoke.

Would you tell us one awesome fact about yourself?

I don't have many, but I met the world's most dangerous hacker at a cybersecurity convention a couple years back!

How come they are the world's most dangerous?

Moreso at the time when he did actively hack, he was arrested for a lot of fraud. However, in a book about him he had mentioned the reason as to why he liked hacking major entities was not for money or any goal pertaining to certain opinions, but because he liked it and it was fun to him. His name is Cody and he's a large Rhodesian Ridgeback and he is absolutely adorable. He has great table manners and is very food driven. He's very strong and loves laying in bed with me. I remember being able to hold him in the palm of my hands, but now he is a chonky boy.

Imagine the game is coming to an end, and you have 30 minutes to an hour to do one last thing, what would it be?

I would probably put a PF up for all the major story instances that captured people's hearts and do them with Waltz and my friends, then probably take one last picture of all of us where we can see everyone for a cool frame.

Interview with . . .

Kai Linh



How did you get into the game?

I was roughly a veteran of ten years of World of Warcraft, as well as DnD Online, Elder Scrolls Online, Star Wars: The Old Republic, and a few other smaller MMOs. I was back into WoW in early 2021 yet again but not having a lot of fun, when I started to hear a lot of buzz surrounding FFXIV. This was around the time of the massive influx of players, and I became one of them!

What's your favorite part of the game?

I think if anybody knows me at all, they can probably figure the answer is Gposing. Specifically, the creativity that the game offers to explore art in a sort of unconventional way. I enjoy the process of building a good Gpose; from the setting to the lighting to the positions, to just the tone and feel I want to convey. I extend this into decorating as well - without a house of my own currently, I am limited on what I can decorate, but I love to try out new decorating ideas. Beyond that, and why I keep coming back, is just the wonderful world and gameplay to go with it, and the ability to just jump in with friends and knock out some content on all of the different fun jobs the game has to offer.

What is your favorite class?

Definitely Reaper. When I first started the game, I started as Dragoon because I liked the idea of a weighty two-handed weapon with some agility to match. Unfortunately, Dragoon didn't deliver in that category completely, as the moves felt agile but not very heavy. And of course the other options, Warrior and Dark Knight, felt weighty as tanks but not very nimble. So when Reaper dropped and had that blend of speed and power, plus just a really fun rotation and toolkit, and enough edge to keep a whole chain of Hot Topics in business, I knew it was the job I had been waiting for.

Which expansion has been your favorite so far?

For main X.0 expansion, Shadowbringers is still the best. I found Heavensward to be thrilling, and despite other naysayers I did enjoy Stormblood as well, but ShB really brought the weight of the story to the forefront for me. And while I do also love Endwalker, it does get just a little bit...out there. I say it's a split answer though, because the HW post content is still some of the best content in the entire game. All of the Dragonsong War stuff following the main story was super exciting.

Who is your favorite NPC(s)?

Alisaie. She is the best girl, she is smart and creative, fearless, determined, and has some of the best character growth in the story to date. I love her to pieces, and would protect her from anything. Additionally, I'll give an immediate special shout out to the best boy, your friend and mine, Haurchefant. And then to go a bit further; Y'shtola is obviously the bossy lady we all want telling us what to do, Hilda is an absolute dreamboat, and Estinien could be my best friend any day.

What's one thing you're looking forward to most in the coming patches?

I am very excited to take the same trip that Y'shtola's little watery friends took in 6.1, and also quite interested to see where things with the individual from the last cinematic of 6.1 end up going.

Do you have a background to your character's name?

Kai is a Hawaiian name that means "Ocean" or "Sea," and Linh is a Vietnamese surname that means "Soul" or "Spirit," so my name translates to something akin to "Ocean Spirit" or "Soul of the Ocean." I like water, my name is about water, now my many many Gposes in Mist and Costa probably make more sense.

What mount is your favorite and what minion is your favorite?

Fat Cat and Fatter Cat, obviously. (Okay - special shout to the new Nier Pod 602 mount and Pod minions, Dress-up Alisaie because Alisbae, and the Construct VII Iron Man suit.)

What is your favorite hangout spot in the game?

Costa Del Sol, without a doubt. I even have a very special location within Costa that has featured in more Gposes than I can count, but the entire zone is wonderful. From the moment I first went there, I was in love. There are a lot of really good zones of course; from II Mheg to Mare Lamentorum, but at the end of the day, the one place I can always go back to and just sit and reflect on things is Costa Del Sol.

Are there any other games you play outside of FFXIV?

Nothing with the some voracity that I give to FFXIV. I do play a lot of other games though - I have been a gamer since I could hold a controller. I got my first console at age four, my first "gaming pc" (very loose term in those days) at age six, and I've never stopped playing ever since. Recently, I played through Deathloop and Kena: Bridge of Spirits on PS5, I'm nearly done with Assassin's Creed: Valhalla and Spiderman: Miles Morales, and just started Nier Replicant and Guardians of the Galaxy.

What hobbies do you have outside of gaming?

I have been an avid comic book reader since I was very young, and have a pretty decent collection of them in my bookcase. I've played Dungeons and Dragons since I was about nine, and still do to this day. I also have played Magic: The Gathering since I was about fourteen or so, and still have quite a lot of cards though I don't get to play as much in recent years, what with ya know... the world situation. Beyond that I like to read, I love listening to music and podcasts, I watch lots and lots of movies, and a probably unhealthy amount of YouTube content.

Are there shows/films or songs you would recommend?

Some of my favorite movies include The Departed, Inception, and Good Will Hunting. For shows I'm a big Breaking Bad and Better Call Saul fan, as well as a lot of the obvious fantasy and sci-fi stuff like Battlestar Galactica, Altered Carbon, Lovecraft Country (short lived as it was, it was brilliant), The Mandalorian, and most of the Marvel shows.

And music? Whew, big question. I'm generally a fan of rock, specifically early 2000s alternative and metal. So some of my favorites bands include Linkin Park, Breaking Benjamin, Rise Against, and System of a Down. However, I'm also a huge Queen fan and a big fan of early Michael Jackson. I also listen to quite a bit of Kendrick Lamar, Hopsin, NF, and Eminem, as well as listening to a pretty good assortment of pop-punk and top 40s stuff.

Next question: Tell us a little bit of what you love to eat, even if it's a snack.

I have... kind of an addiction to Twizzlers. I mean, I eat a lot of things - many of the usuals like tacos, pizza, burgers, steak, salads, lots of fruit, pretty normal stuff. But, yeah, Twizzlers are my weakness, I pretty much always have some nearby at my PC.

Is there a certain flavor of Twizzlers that you enjoy, or is it just any of the flavors will do?

Classic strawberry for me!

Tell us one awesome fact about yourself.

Well, I've wanted to be a stand-up comedian since I was seven years old. That's pretty interesting, most people seem to think.

There are people from around the world that play this game, where do you play from?

I'm in Michigan (U.S. for anybody not in the States). Originally from Ohio, but I've lived in Michigan for nearly half my life now (and for a brief period I lived in Las Vegas).

If you were able to, would you be down to meet people outside of this game? If so, what do you think would be your first reaction when you first see them?

I'm kind of a shy person, but I've met people I played WoW with and they were really nice and I still talk to them to this day. First reaction though? I'm a hugger...some people take that the wrong way, but I like hugs and I give very good hugs and I won't apologize for this.

We share lots of adorable pet photos. If you have a pet, what kind of pet is it, or if you want to own a pet, which one would it be?

I have a cat! His name is Jax, and he is old and fat and a jerk, but he's also adorable and cuddly so he is hard to stay mad at.

All right, I'm going to probably make you sad, just a bit, ready? The game is coming to an end, you have thirty minutes to an hour to do one last thing, what would it be?

What else? Gpose! Get together everybody I can for one big, final, grand Gpose that I would put every ounce of effort and creativity I had into making the best one I've ever done. I can think of no more fitting end than to immortalize an amazing group of people in an amazing game.

That is a great idea, and with what we've seen you do before it would be a masterpiece.

There's a quote from my favorite video game, What Remains of Edith Finch, that I think of quite often: "If we lived forever, maybe we'd have time to understand things. But as it is, I think the best we can do is try to open our eyes, and appreciate how strange and brief all of this is."



Tamarind soup with shrimp By: Ashildr Stormcaller



Ingredients:

- -4 cups water
- -3 medium ripe tomatoes, quartered
- ~1 medium onion (yellow or red), quartered
- ~1 medium radish, sliced
- ~1½ pound large shrimp
- -1 pack (22g) tamarind mix (Sinigang Mix)
- -1 small bunch yard-long beans, chunked
- 6 pieces okra
- ~1 medium eggplant, sliced
- -2-3 pieces green finger chili
- ~2-3 tablespoons fish sauce
- ~1 bunch water spinach, tips and upper stalk only (or bok choi chunked, or regular spinach)



Directions:

- Bring 1 liter of water in a pot to a boil over medium-high heat.
- ~ Add the tomatoes and onions. Cook for 2 minutes. Add the radish and cook for another 2 minutes.
- Add the shrimp. Once the shrimp turn pink, add the tamarind mix. Simmer for about 2 minutes.
- ~ Add the beans followed by the okra, and chili. Bring back to boil and cook for 2 minutes.
- ~ Season with fish sauce and add the eggplant. Cook for a minute and, lastly, add the water spinach. Push the leaves down gently until submerged. Simmer for another minute.

Lemon Garlic Salmon By: Yvahli Tontalu



Ingredients:

- -1½ pounds whole salmon fillet, skin on
- ~ kosher salt
- black pepper
- 2 tablespoons light olive oil
- ~1 tablespoon minced garlic
- ~1 teaspoon lemon zest
- $-\frac{1}{4}$ cup lemon juice
- ~ ½ teaspoon kosher salt
- ¼ teaspoon black pepper
- ~ 3 tablespoons unsalted butter
- ~1 tablespoon dill leaves
- ~1 tablespoon minced parsley
- 4 lemon wedges



Directions:

Remove scales from skin. Cut fish into 2 inch filets and pat dry with paper towel. Let sit for 10 minutes to hit room temp. Season generously with salt on both sides (if any moisture beads up, pat again before frying).

In stainless steel, cast iron, or nonstick pan, heat oil over medium heat until simmering (not smoking). Add fish skin-side down and press with fish spatula to keep flat. Cook for about 5-6 minutes or until 75-80% of fish looks cooked. Remove from pan and let rest skin-side up.

In the same pan over medium heat, saute minced garlic, lemon zest, and fresh lemon juice until fragrant. To thicken, turn off the heat and whisk in cold butter until combined. Add dill and parsley before serving. Pairs well with guinoa, green beans, and asparagus.

Korean beef with veggies and rice By: O'zetta Lagi

Ingredients:

- ~1 pound lean ground beef
- ~5 cloves garlic, crushed
- –1 tablespoon freshly grated ginger
- ~ 2 teaspoons toasted sesame oil
- -1/2 cup reduced-sodium soy sauce
- 1/3 cup light brown sugar
- ~1/4 teaspoon crushed red pepper
- -6 green onions, chopped, divided
- -4 cups hot cooked brown rice
- ~1 tablespoon toasted sesame seeds



Directions:

- Heat a large skillet over medium–high heat. Add beef and cook, stirring and crumbling into small pieces until browned, 5 to 7 minutes. Drain excess grease.
- ~ Stir in garlic, ginger, and sesame oil and cook until fragrant, about 2 minutes. Stir in soy sauce, brown sugar, and red pepper. Cook until beef absorbs some sauce, about 7 minutes. Add 1/2 of chopped green onions.
- ~ Serve over hot cooked rice; garnish with sesame seeds and remaining green onions.

Biscuits and Gravy By: Mufinella Pemstein



Ingredients:

- ~ one pack of Italian sausage, mild
- -1/2 cup of vidalia onion, finely diced
- -2 cloves of garlic, minced
- two thsp butter (less if your sausage is extra greasy cause you want about 3 thsp fat for the roux)
- ~3 tbsp flour
- ~ 3 cups whole milk
- dash black pepper
- ~ dash salt
- dash onion powder
- dash garlic powder
- dash cumin
- ~1 can Grands flakey buttermilk biscuits



Directions:

Brown the sausage in pan and crumble into small pieces. Add onions and garlic once the sausage is no longer pink and brown together. Remove sausage from pan, try to collect as much grease from it as possible and return the grease to the pan. Add butter as necessary.

Heat fat to sizzle, add flour, whisk constantly until you get a nice browned coloring on your roux (not too dark or you've burnt it, this is just to cook the flour so it doesn't taste raw).

Take pan off heat, add some milk, stirring to incorporate the roux. Add rest of milk and heat. Add in spices, tasting until it is to your liking (don't get too heavy-handed with the cumin cause it can overpower the dish). Simmer over medium heat until thickened, then add meat back in. Heat through.

Serve over biscuits!

Shane's Arrabbiata Sauce By: Istari Xiomar



Ingredients:

- ~12 Large Cloves of Garlic
- -4-5 Tbsp Olive Oil
- -1/2 Tsp Salt
- ~1 Medium Yellow Onion, diced
- ~1~6 Tsps crushed red pepper flakes
- ~ 228oz cans of whole tomatoes (San

Marzano is the best) OR 128oz can of whole tomatoes and 128oz can of diced tomatoes

- 1/2 small can of tomato paste
- $\sim 1/2$ cup (packed) of fresh basil (or 2 tbsp of dried basil)



~ Heat the oil in a large sauce pan on low heat. Add garlic and chilli flakes and sauté for 5 minutes to infuse the oil. Stir occasionally.

- Turn heat up to medium-high, add the onions and sauté for another 3-5 minutes, stirring as necessary. The onions will become shiny and translucent.

- Add the tomatoes, paste, and salt. Let the sauce simmer and then reduce heat to low. Use a wooden spoon, fork, or potato masher to slowly break down the tomatoes. Let the sauce simmer for 25 - 35 mins, stirring as necessary and using the masher/fork/spoon to keep breaking down the tomatoes throughout the simmer. Add basil and let simmer for another 15 minutes.

Eorzean Chronicles A deeper look into the lore of FFXIV

11: The Twelve


For as long as history has been written, the land of Eorzea was ruled by the mysterious gods and goddesses known as "The Twelve". Aided by their loyal subjects, the Moogles, they ruled these lands until the arrival of wandering tribes: the Elezen, Miqo'te, Lalafell, Roegadyn, and Hyur. The gods were impressed by the resourcefulness and resilience of these tribes, awarding the lands of Eorzea to these travelers and becoming patron dieties of what we know to be the Eorzean city states today.

Not much else is known of these mysterious beings, thought to be nothing more than legend by many residents of Eorzea as memory of them has faded with the passage of time. There power is aught to be seen of their existence, believers able to call upon their might in their craft and even in the heat of battle. One such example of their aid can be noted in the Sharlayan scholar Louisoix Leveilleur calling upon their power with the aid of the Warrior of Light to defeat Bahamut. While the ritual ultimately failed, the summoning of the Twelve's powers resulted in spires of light piercing Bahamut in place for a period of time, allowing time for Louisoix to get the Warriors of Light to safety.

What we do know of the Twelve, or have theorized, can be documented thusly. Each pair of the Twelve commands one of the six elements and each is associated with a month of the Eorzean calendar. Each elemental pair is, conversely, tied to one of the six constellations of the Source's night sky. From there, each god and goddess is broken down further into unique powers offered to those who worship them.



Halone, the Fury, mover of glaciers and goddess of war, commands the element of ice and is tied to the First Astral Moon (first month). She is depicted as a relentless warrior holding a bronze greatshield, and her symbol is three spears. Halone is the daughter of Rhalgr, sister to elder brother Byregot, and bitter rivals with Nophica. Statues in her visage can be found around Ishgard as she stands as the patron of the Holy See.



iated with the First Umbral Moon (second month). She is depicted as a maid carrying a round skillet. Her symbol is the full greater moon. Menphina is the younger sister of Azeyma, and the divine lover of Oschon. Dalamud was often referred to as "Menphina's Loyal Hound" prior to its fall; during the advent of the Seventh Umbral Era, this often changed to less flattering things like "Menphina's Bastard Hound". The Keeper of the Moon Miqo'te traditionally worship Menphina.



Thaliak, the Scholar, ruler of rivers and wisdom and god of knowledge, commands the element of water and is tied to the Second Astral Moon (third month). He is depicted as a reserved scholar holding an ashen staff, and his symbol is the scroll. Thaliak is the patron of Sharlayan, Byregot's teacher, and father of Llymlaen. A statue in his visage can be seen overlooking the ships entering Sharlayan, standing proud as he pours out a pot of water into the harbor.

Nymeia, the Spinner, the watcher of celestial bodies and goddess of fate, commands the element of water and is

associated with the Second Umbral Moon (fourth month). She is depicted as a weaver donning a white, silken veil. Her symbol is the spinning wheel. She is the younger sister of Althyk, and the master of Rhalgr. Nymeia briefly became the matron deity of Ala Mhigo during the reign of King Theodoric from 1552 to the city-state's fall in 1557. Bouquets of Nymeia Lilies are placed upon lichstones as an offering to the dead.

Llymlaen, the Navigator, watcher of the seas and goddess of navigation, commands the element of wind and is tied to the Third Astral Moon (fifth month). She is depicted as a strong fisherwoman holding a long-bladed harpoon, and her symbol is the wave. Llymlaen is the daughter of Thaliak and the elder sister of Nophica. Llymlaen is also the patron of Limsa Lominsa. A statue in her visage can be found in the center of Aleport in Western La Noscea.

Oschon, the Wanderer, ruler of the mountains and god of vagrants, commands the element of wind and is associated with the Third Umbral Moon (sixth month). He is depicted as a carefree ranger wielding a bow of yew. His symbol is the walking stick. Oschon is the brother of Nald'thal, a close companion of Halone, and the divine lover of Menphina. The Wanderer's Palace was originally dedicated to Oschon by the people of Nym, who worshipped him as their patron deity.

Byregot, the Builder, is a god of the arts who commands the element of lightning and is tied to the Fourth Astral Moon (seventh month). A purveyor of architecture and industry, he is depicted as an ardent smith holding a two-headed hammer, and his symbol is the hand. Byregot is the son of Rhalgr and the elder brother of Halone. Byregot is also Thaliak's pupil.

Rhalgr, the Destroyer, breaker of worlds and god of destruction, commands the element of lightning and is tied to the Fourth Umbral Moon (eighth month). He is depicted as a magus carrying a bronze staff, and his symbol is the streaking meteor. Father of both Byregot and Halone, he is the attendant to Nymeia, and guardian deity of Ala Mhigo. A massive statue in his honor can be found at the center of Rhalgr's Reach.

Azeyma, the Warden, keeper of the sun and goddess of inquiry, commands the element of fire and is tied to the Fifth Astral Moon (ninth month). She is depicted as a noble lady holding a golden fan, and her symbol is the radiant sun. She is the mother of Nophica, the elder sister of Menphina, and the daughter of Althyk. The Seekers of the Sun's devotion to her pervades their culture.



Nald'thal, the Traders, actually the single manifestation of twin deities: Nald, keeper of the living, and Thal, keeper of the dead. Gods of commerce, they are together an overseer of transactions and the underworld with power over the element of fire and ties to the Fifth Umbral Moon (tenth month). Nald'thal is depicted as a discerning merchant holding a balance while symbolized by the the cowry, an ancient shell currency. Oschon is Nald'thal's brother. The Order of Nald'thal is a religious order that reveres the Traders. Two great halls, devoted to the twin aspects of Nald'thal, can be found in the eastern and western sections of the city of Ul'dah. Milvaneth Sacrarium is dedicated to Nald and Arrzaneth Ossuary is dedicated to Thal.



Nophica, the Matron, tender of soils and harvests and goddess of abundance, commands the element of earth and is tied to the Sixth Astral Moon (eleventh month). She is depicted as a jubilant farmer holding a steel scythe, and her symbol is the spring leaf. Daughter of Azeyma, Nophica is the younger sister of Llymlaen, and the bitter rival of Halone. Nophica is also the patron of Gridania. Nophica's Altar, a great stone platter set within the hollow of an ancient tree, can be found on the path

to the Stillglade Fane in Gridania. Her likeness can be seen in a Twin Adders poster.

Althyk, the Keeper, the surveyor of change and god of space and time, commands the element of earth and is associated with the Sixth Umbral Moon (twelfth month). He is depicted as an austere emperor wielding a mythril greataxe. His symbol is the hourglass. He is the father of Azeyma and Menphina, and elder brother to Nymeia. Louisoix conjured the power of Althyk

during the final battle with Bahamut to deliver the adventurers to a safer place.

While the truth of the Twelve may yet be shrouded in mystery, perhaps we will discover more in our future adventures. Who knows, they may be walking among us. . . even now.
