Good Neighbor Policy

The Board for the Reems Creek Homeowners Association is a collective of resident volunteers. The Board fosters an environment in which all board members, volunteers, committee chairs, residents, and other individuals are treated with decency and respect. Accordingly, we expect and require all individuals of the Reems Creek Golf Community, when communicating with each other, to follow these principles:

- Communicate in a manner that is conducive to effective working relationships.
- Work with others to create an environment in which all are inspired to interact through mutual respect, support, and appreciation of differences.
- Unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated. This includes board members as well as residents of the Reems Creek Golf Community.
 - Do not use abusive language, bullying, intimidation, or otherwise.
 - > Do not engage in physically threatening remarks (written or verbal).
 - ➤ Do not engage in aggressive or hostile acts such as shouting, assaulting, aggressively using profanity, throwing objects at another person, fighting, or intentionally damaging another person's property.
 - > Do not engage in behavior that could create a reasonable fear of injury, such as stalking.
- Lastly, all members of the board should strive to carry out all assigned responsibilities to the best of their abilities.

Please note: If any resident approaches a RCHOA volunteer in an unacceptable manner, the volunteer should cease all communication until the resident approaches again in a proper manner. The same holds for resident-to-resident communications.
