

Tree Removal Guideline

(revised July 2022)

The purpose of this guideline is to provide residents of Reems Creek Golf Community a clear understanding of the rules regarding tree removal as written in the RCGC Covenants and Restrictions, Article 12.

No trees measuring six (6) inches or more in diameter at a point two (2) feet above ground level, no flowering trees or shrubs, nor any evergreens (collectively referred to as “Trees”) may be removed without the written approval of the Homeowners Association.

Exceptions to these rules include Trees located within fifteen (15) feet of a house, damaged Trees, Trees that need to be removed in an emergency, or Trees that are in the right of way of driveways under construction. Although these exceptions are allowed, homeowners/lot owners should inform the ARC before any removal. Other information you may find helpful:
