The Garland County Fair and Livestock Association welcomes you to the Fair Pageant! We hope you will enjoy your experience at our pageant.

Qualifications, Rules, Regulations and Policies:

- 1.** Contestants must be at least 13 years of age and not more than 17 years of age on the opening day of our County Fair, September 10, 2021.
- 2.** A contestant must be a Garland County resident to compete in the Junior Miss Garland County Fair Pageant. Contestants cannot be married, engaged, annulled marriage, pregnant, miscarried, aborted, or have had a child. A contestant must not have ever been convicted of any crime or have any criminal charges pending.
- 3.** Contestants are required to be on time for all rehearsals and events. Absent or tardy contestants may be disqualified at the discretion of the Contest Director and/or County Fair Management. Rehearsal is scheduled for Sunday, September 12, 2021, at 2 p.m. Pageant check in time will be announced at rehearsal. If you are unable to attend or be on time, due to an emergency, contact Jane Oliver at (501) 520-1333 or Peggy Barnett (501) 623-9592.
- 4.** A contestant must always conduct herself properly. Any display of bad sportsmanship, inappropriate behavior bringing unfavorable publicity to herself and/or the Garland County Fair may result in disqualification of the contestant not only from this year's contest but all future contests.
- 5.** Contestant must turn in entry form and fees by deadline. Entries may be mailed, or hand delivered. If mailing, please allow plenty of time for forms to arrive. The Garland County Fair Association will not be responsible for entry forms lost or delayed in transit by any shipping method. There will be no additions or corrections made once the form is submitted.
- 6.** The Garland County Fair Association is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged property. Please treat the facility with the utmost respect and clean up after yourself when the event is over.

Clothing:

- Rehearsal – Since the rehearsal is closed to the public, contestants are free to wear comfortable clothing. We recommend the contestants rehearse in the same shoes they will wear in each phase of competition.

- Sportswear – Sports attire representing a favorite athletic-type sport such as baseball, tennis, cheerleading, hunting, fishing, gymnastics, dance etc. Props are acceptable but must be carried. They cannot be used to demonstrate a sport.
- Evening Gowns– Evening Gown of choice. Jewelry and accessories should be tasteful and compliment the gown. High-heeled shoes are recommended, but not required.

Dressing Area: Each contestant must be accompanied by ONE adult while in dressing room and backstage. NO CELL PHONES and NO CAMERAS ALLOWED IN THE DRESSING AREA! The Garland County Fair Association is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged property. Please treat the facility with the utmost respect and clean up after yourself when the event is over. Our dressing area is small and can get crowded. Please be respectful.

Judging: Fair and impartial judges are chosen for the pageant. Contestants and/or parents are not to approach the judges at any time. Their decision will be final. All contestants are judged on: Stage Presentation, Personality and Overall Appearance. Score sheets will NOT be available at any time for viewing.
