The Garland County Fair and Livestock Association welcomes you to the Fair Youth Pageant! We hope you will enjoy your experience at our pageant. Please read carefully all paperwork provided to you. Necessary paperwork for District and State Pageants will be provided on the night of September 13. **DO NOT LEAVE** the Pageant Building without completing necessary paperwork!

QUALIFICATIONS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND POLICIES

1. Contestant must be a resident of Garland County and age is determined by contestant age on the opening day of our County Fair (September 9, 2022).
2. Contestant must turn in entry form and fees by deadline. **No entries will be accepted after August 29, 2022.** Entries may be mailed, or hand delivered. If mailing, please allow plenty of time for forms to arrive. The Garland County Fair Association will not be responsible for entry forms lost or delayed in transit by any shipping method. There will be no additions or corrections made once the form is submitted.
3. Contestant is required to be on time and present for the rehearsal. Contestant is required to be on time for the pageant check-in. Rehearsal is scheduled for Sunday, September 11, 2022. (The time will be announced at a later date.) Pageant check in time will be announced at rehearsal.
4. Attire for pageant: Your choice of pageant dress, flower girl style dress, formal, or Sunday best. Makeup is allowed but should be age appropriate and used with discretion. This is **NOT** a glitz pageant. **In no way does the cost or style of the contestant's attire have a bearing on the outcome of the pageant results.**
5. Each contestant must be accompanied by ONE female adult while in dressing room and backstage. **NO MALES! NO CELL PHONES and NO CAMERAS ALLOWED IN THE DRESSING AREA!** You will be dismissed if you are using a camera or phone in the dressing area.
6. Crowd Favorite: This is the contestant who has the most votes sold by them before the pageant. There will be 3 winning contestants: 1 from the Youth, Jr. Queen and Queen Pageants. Votes are \$1 each or 6 votes for \$5. Contestants who choose to sell tickets need to bring all money and tickets sold to the Rehearsal on September 11th and turn them in. Tickets need to be filled out completely. Ticket sales have absolutely no bearing on the

pageant or pageant outcome at all. The contestant who sells the most tickets will be deemed "Crowd Favorite".

7. Any display of bad sportsmanship and/or unbecoming conduct, any interference and/or disturbance, foul language, or any other behavioral problem created by a contestant, parent, relative or supporter of a contestant could result in disqualification of the contestant not only from this year's pageant but all future contests.
8. The Garland County Fair Association is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged property. Please treat the facility with the utmost respect and clean up after yourself when the event is over.
9. Fair and impartial judges are chosen for the pageant. **Contestants and/or parents are not to approach the judges at any time.** Their decision will be final. All contestants are judged on: Facial Beauty, Stage Presentation, Attitude/Personality and Overall Appearance. Score sheets will NOT be available at any time for viewing.
10. The Directors of the Garland County Fair Pageant reserve the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of or connected with, or incident to the contest, and the right to amend or add to these rules as their judgment may determine. Any contestant who fails to abide by any of the above rules can be disqualified from the competition by the Director(s).
