Qualifications and Rules

Sweetheart: (3-4 years old)

1. Contestants must not be less than 3 years of age or more than 4 years of age as of September 1 of the current year. 2. The contestant must be single; never been married, pregnant and/or had a child. 3. The contestant must be a female legal resident of the state of Arkansas. 4. The contestant may be amateur or professional. Cannot hold an out of state title. 5. Past Arkansas State Fair Rodeo Queens are not eligible to compete again. 6. NO STALLIONS ARE PERMITTED. 7. Entry constitutes agreement to release Arkansas Livestock Show Association from all liability.

Little Miss: (5-8 years old)

1. Contestants must not be less than 5 years of age or more than 8 years of age as of September 1 of the current year. 2. The contestant must be single; never been married, pregnant and/or had a child. 3. The contestant must be a female legal resident of the state of Arkansas. 4. The contestant may be amateur or professional. Cannot hold an out of state title. 5. Past Arkansas State Fair Rodeo Queens are not eligible to compete again. 6. NO STALLIONS ARE PERMITTED. 7. Entry constitutes agreement to release Arkansas Livestock Show Association from all liability.

Princess: (9-13 years old)

1. Contestants must not be less than 9 years of age or more than 13 years of age as of September 1 of the current year. 2. The contestant must be single; never been married, pregnant and/or had a child. 3. The contestant must be a female legal resident of the state of Arkansas. 4. The contestant may be amateur or professional. Cannot hold an out of state title. 5. Past Arkansas State Fair Rodeo Queens are not eligible to compete again. 6. NO STALLIONS ARE PERMITTED. 7. Entry constitutes agreement to release Arkansas Livestock Show Association from all liability.

Jr Rodeo Queen: (14-17 years old)

1. Contestants must not be less than 14 or more than 17 years of age as of September 1 of the current year. 2. The contestant must be single; never been married, pregnant and/or had a child. 3. The contestant must be a female legal resident of the state of Arkansas. 4. The contestant may be amateur or professional. Cannot hold an out of state title. 5. Past Arkansas State Fair Rodeo Queens are not eligible to compete again. 6. NO STALLIONS ARE PERMITTED. 7. Entry constitutes agreement to release Arkansas Livestock Show Association from all liability.

Sr Rodeo Queen: (18-21 years old)

1. Contestants must not be less than 18 or more than 21 years of age as of September 1 of the current year. 2. The contestant must be single; never been married, pregnant and/or had a child. 3. The contestant must be a female legal resident of the state of Arkansas. 4. The contestant may be amateur or professional. Cannot hold an out of state title. 5. Past Arkansas State Fair Rodeo Queens are not eligible to compete again. 6. NO STALLIONS ARE PERMITTED. 7. Entry constitutes agreement to release Arkansas Livestock Show Association from all liability.

MS. Rodeo Queen: (22-26 years old)

1. Contestants must not be less than 22 or more than 26 years of age as of September 1 of the current year. 2. The contestant must be a female legal resident of the state of Arkansas. 3. The contestant may be amateur or professional. Cannot hold an out of state title. 4. Past Arkansas State Fair Rodeo Queens are not eligible to compete again. 5. NO STALLIONS ARE PERMITTED. 6. Entry constitutes agreement to release Arkansas Livestock Show Association from all liability.

PLEASE READ ALL RULES

<u>CHAPERONES</u>: Contestants must be accompanied by a parent/guardian or female chaperone appointed by parent/guardian. The chaperone must be present at registration and remain with the contestant throughout the contest.

<u>HORSES:</u> Arkansas horses must be accompanied by the original report of negative EIA test within 12 months prior to exhibition. Horses from out of state require the original report of negative EIA test within 12 months AND original health certificate issued within 30 days prior to exhibition. Health Certificate must include individual identification and temperature reading of animal. Photocopies are not acceptable.

<u>DRESS REQUIREMENTS:</u> Each contestant should come prepared with enough WESTERN ATTIRE for the event, including an interview session, modeling and impromptu question, and Horsemanship competition. During the Horsemanship Competition, contestants can wear your choice of long sleeve western attire and jeans. Hats are required during all phases of the competition, including the interview. Chaps are not allowed.

<u>JUDGING:</u> Faith Castle, director, will appoint 2 judges for Appearance, Personality, and Horsemanship. They will be well qualified to judge a contest of this kind. Manners, behavior, and grooming will be observed at all times from registration to the crowning ceremony. Their decision is <u>final</u>. Poor sportsmanship, tardiness, interference, or

otherwise inappropriate conduct will affect your score. Rule violations could result in disqualification, from this and future contests.

ALL 6 WINNERS ARE REQUIRED TO COME BACK DURING THE FAIR WEEK AT LEAST 1 NIGHT AND GIVE OUT AWARDS AND ATTEND THE GARLAND COUNTY FAIR RODEO.

ALL 4 WINNERS IN LITTLE MISS- SR QUEEN WILL CONTINUE ON AND COMPETE AT THE ARKANSAS STATE FAIR RODEO QUEEN
COMPETITION. IF THE WINNER CAN NOT ATTEND, THE FIRST RUNNER UP WILL TAKE HER PLACE AND COMPETE AT THE ARKANSAS STATE FAIR.

- You will have up to 4 minutes to complete your pattern.

There will be a Queen run at the end of horsemanship, you will be judged.

Cannot be led on lead line without a disqualification from the horsemanship portion of the competition.

Sr. Rodeo Queen:

You're required to execute the following maneuvers:

- Two large fast circles to the left
- Simple or flying lead change
- Two large fast circles to the right
- Two stops
- · Back one horse length
- Spins four to the right and four to the left
- All bullet points can be done in any order during the pattern.
- You will have up to 4 minutes to complete your pattern.

There will be a Queen run at the end of horsemanship, you will be judged.

Cannot be led on lead line without a disqualification from the horsemanship portion of the competition.


Ms. Rodeo Queen:

You're required to execute the following maneuvers:


- Four large fast circles to the left

Cannot be led on lead line without a disqualification from the horsemanship portion of the competition.




SWEETHEART

- 1. Jog from A to B
- 2. Jog around B
- 3. Extend the Jog to C
- 4. Stop at C and Back four steps



LITTLE MISS

Start at A

- 1. Jog from A to B
- 2. Lope around B on the left lead
- 3. Break to an extended Jog and continue to C
- 4. Stop at C and Back four steps

PRINCESS
