Week 1 & 2– Discussing Ramadan and The plant life cycle. Sight word list 6-8

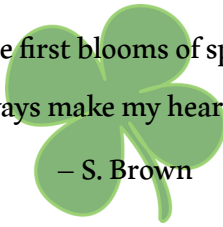
Week 3 & 4– Welcoming Spring and discussing the celebrations of Holi. Sight word list 6-8 and skip counting by 2's & 3's

Shamrock playdough



What you'll need:

-1 cup of flour -1 cup of water -1/4 cup of salt -2tsp cream of tartar - 1tbs of cooking oil -6-8 drops of food

dye -gold glitter

Mix the ingredients together and cook over medium heat while stirring for a few minutes. Remove the dough from the pan and let it cool. You can then squish and squeeze it until it forms a playdough consistency. Once complete, you can add gold glitter to make it extra festive!
