"An Injury to One is an Injury to All"

It would be nice to report some good news this Holiday Season, but unfortunately our Pension Trust trustees have decided to take "no action" regarding the three retirees who were "overpaid" by the trust. Last month I reported that the retirees received a letter from the trust stating there will be a reduction in future retirement benefits due to the failure of the previous Trust Administrator to accurately determine their benefit. In each case, the retiree selected the Social Security Offset. Each case has its own circumstances that should have led the Trust to deal with these individuals in a more humane manner. Instead, the new Trust administrator has been directed to keep collecting these alleged overpayments which range from \$45,000 to \$140,000, reducing each pension check by up to 25%.

Last month REACTA retained an attorney with expertise in ERISA issues which confirmed that the Trust can only go back and recover up to three years of overpayments. The Trust administrator is going back up the NINE years! If the Trust is allowed to skirt the law in California, it has tremendous impact on ALL current CTA employees and retirees whether CAS, CSO, Confidential, Supervisory, Leadership or Management. I sent a background paper to the Trustees outlining our concerns and offering better solutions. Our Legal Opinion was also shared with the Trustees. To date, I have not received a response!

REACTA is committed to provide the support necessary to assist these retirees. What happened to these retirees could happen to other retirees if a calculation error is discovered. This brings true meaning to the motto "An Injury to One is an Injury to All!"

REACTA recently learned about the passing of Ara Prigen. Ara was a long time CTA staff member and worked in most areas of the state! The REACTA Facebook page has many comments about Ara and his commitment to his colleagues. Ara retired in September and immediately joined REACTA. May he RIP.
