## **Annual Reunion and Meeting Registration Opens**

Our 2022 Annual Reunion and Meeting will take place on October 3-5 at the Oxford Suites in Paso Robles. Our new location will offer us many opportunities to explore an area with lots of attractions including very noteworthy wineries! Downtown Paso is loaded with shops and fine restaurants and only a short distance from our hotel. There is a nearby train station allowing members in the north and south to avoid driving to our meeting. The hotel will offer free shuttle service to Downtown Paso as well as the train station. You can now make your hotel room reservation by calling the hotel at **(805) 237-0305**. Be sure to tell them you're with the REACTA Annual Meeting. We have reserved several handicapped accessible sleeping rooms at the same price as stated below. All rooms are accessible by elevator to all REACTA activities. If you have any questions or concerns, feel free to ask for our meeting contact, Q Medina, at the same hotel number. Rates are as follows:

- Standard 2 queen is \$134 (Sunday 10/2/22), \$121.00 (Monday 10/3/22) and \$132 (Tuesday 10/4/22).
- Rate for a king suite is \$140 (Sunday (10/2/22), \$127.00 (Monday 10/3/22) and \$138 (Tuesday 10/4/22).
- Rate for a Deluxe Family 2 King Suite is \$246.00 (Sunday 10/3/22), \$232.00 (Monday, 10/3/22) and \$244 (Tuesday 10/4/22).

These rates are for single/double occupancy - a \$10.00 charge will be added for each additional person. REACTA room rates will be honored one (1) day before and after our meeting dates listed. **Room reservations must be made by August 18, 2022 for these rates to apply.** We suggest you call right away before all rooms are taken.

Check in is after 4:00 pm and check out is 11:00 am. You have to cancel no later than three days prior to your arrival date to avoid any charges.
