## GOALS OF THE JOHANNESBURG SUMMIT

26 August - 4 September 2002

Because the 21<sup>st</sup> century will be the defining century for Earth's future, this summit could be the most significant event of this century, even of this millennium. Never before have we been at the crossroads at which we now stand. We now have the capacity to kill the Earth very easily in several ways. We must consider the questions we must answer if life is to continue.

By the end of this century, what will be our condition and the condition of the Earth if we continue on our present path? What will we do about population? Poverty? Can and will we attempt to reverse our destruction of the natural world? Our responses to these questions will determine the answer to the fundamental question of whether any form of life on this planet will survive.

But answering those questions will only take us so far. To go further, the delegates assembled in Johannesburg must form a plan that can become the basis of action. We must lay out a global agenda that coordinates international responses to the army of problems we face, but that also empowers local people and local organizations to address the same problems effectively in their own areas. Both aspects are equally important.

### WHAT TO DO NOW?

To accomplish that task, we must chart a new course. One of the most important lessons we have learnt in the ten years since Rio is that without a global approach, we will never succeed in overcoming the crisis we face in achieving a sustainable way for all creatures to live together on this planet. We do not need an Indian plan or an American plan. We need a global plan for climate change, population control, ozone depletion, water development, technology, and the rest – a plan that combines global vision with local actions and control.

Our task is to create a people's movement round the world to ring the changes and build the world we envision. Good intentions are not enough. Meeting the challenge requires the labor of people working together at the grassroots level around the world, united as citizens of the world, working for a common purpose: to create a world that is just, equitable, and sustainable, and good, not only for all humans but sustainable for all living beings.

Obviously, a major social revolution is required, and that is possible if we can bring another major institutional revolution – to eliminate the division that institutionalized religion and political ideologies place between people. We need a religion and an ideology that brings us common ethics and unites people under the values of development, unity, justice, and equity. That is the religion that we all must learn to share, regardless of what name we call the divine power.

The challenge is great. We may succeed or we may fail to meet it. But if we do not put our labor behind our ideals, then failure is assured not only for all of humanity, but also for our planet. The human journey began in Africa. It now takes us back to Africa to lay the foundation for the next stage of our evolution, one on which the future of the Earth itself depends.

**I N V I T A T I O N**

Hon'ble Sir/Madam,

On behalf of over 27,000 students of City Montessori School (CMS), representing world's two billion children and generation yet unborn, we take great pleasure in inviting you to the 5<sup>th</sup> International Conference of Chief Justices of the World on Article 51© of the Constitution of India to be held in Lucknow (India) on 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> December 2004.

CMS is recognized by the **Guinness Book of World Records** as the world's largest city-school with over 27,000 students enrolled. CMS is also the world's only school to receive the **UNESCO Prize for Peace Education**, in the year 2002. CMS upholds that "**School must act as a Lighthouse of Society**" and provide meaningful education, spiritual direction and leadership not only to students but also to the parents and the society at large, and must concern itself with the affairs of the age. Hence this initiative on children's behalf.

Victor Hugo once observed: "There is one thing stronger than all the armies in the world and that is an idea whose time has come". We believe "Enforceable International Law" is the IDEA whose time has come, and this is the theme of the Conference. In the four conferences convened by CMS, Hon'ble Justices from a large number of countries of the world unanimously endorsed the idea of urgent need for universally applicable enforceable International Law, which alone can ensure world unity and world peace.

A highlight of the ensuing Conference will be a presentation by CMS students – on behalf of world's two billion children and generations yet unborn – wherein they will appeal to the World Judiciary to safeguard their future including their right to a safe and healthy ecology

Over half a century ago, on 24<sup>th</sup> October 1945, when representatives from 51 countries ratified the UN Charter – two months and 18 days after the bombing of Hiroshima, when humanity itself was wounded – they were motivated by the noble desire to save succeeding generations and children born and yet to be born who are the common denominators of all nations, from the scourge of war. The founding fathers of United Nations realised that unity is a prerequisite for peace and that there can be no world peace unless there is world unity.

However, the framers of the UN Charter failed to devise a "common thread" for building member countries into one global family. In the absence of such a "common thread" the UNO has become an organization of "Disunited Nations". The killing power of the countries with veto power are causing fear and suspicion amongst other countries who, for their survival, seek similar killing powers by developing nuclear and other weapons of mass destruction. The present UNO has not been able to unite the world or to bring about world peace, hence a new International Political order is imminent with a duly constituted World Parliament empowered to enact enforceable World Law, without which humanity will be doomed.

If we have to save humankind from the impending catastrophes of a nuclear holocaust and ecodisaster and from vicious threat of terrorism, humanity has to find a common thread for binding all the countries of the world into one global family. The time has come to unite the world in one thread of "Enforceable World Law" because only universally applicable "Enforceable International Law" can regulate international behaviour and bind all countries by thread of law and prevent acts



against humanity, thus realizing the ancient Indian concept of “Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam”, that is “The Earth is but One Country and Mankind its Citizens”. In this regard Article 51 of the Constitution of India acts as a beacon which, inter alia, provides for fostering “respect for international law”.

Children of the world are the common denominator, the reason why all countries must come together to this **CMS Peace Table** laid on behalf of world’s two billion children and generations yet unborn – to banish the scourge of wars forever. We therefore invite you to the 5<sup>th</sup> International Conference of Chief Justices of the World and support the children’s call for a New World Order with a duly-constituted World Parliament empowered to enact Law **Enforceable International Law** that is applicable to all the countries and peoples of the world with no provision for any veto or special powers for anyone.

## URGENCY FOR THE STRUCTURE OF THE EARTH'S CHARTER

There was a time when people traveled from one place to another with great difficulty. They had to travel mostly on foot or in carts driven by horses, mules and other type of animals depending of one's global area. Over the past couple of hundred years, improvement in transportation began to bring the people of various regions closer together than ever before. This was due to the invention of trains, automobiles and airplanes in particular.

### Creation of a Bright Future

As a result, the various regions of the world began to feel the need for greater cooperation between them on basis of mutual beneficial interests. They tend now to transcend the boundaries of past divisions that led to conflicts and wars with tragic consequences. Such divisions stem from a variety of differences ranging from emerged to create an Earth Charter that may serve as a constitution for planet earth.

Since World War II ended in 1945, there were several organizations that come forward to create some sort of document that would eventually serve as a basis to give all nations a sense of unity and security at the same time. One of such documents was the **Constitution for the Federation of Earth**. It would certainly be advisable for those who look forward to seeing the structure of the Earth's Charter to get hold of this well written Constitution. THE Federation Of Earth does not make any nation lose its identity. In fact, every nation can retain its flag, its language, its culture, and its religious practices in addition to

numerous other things. Such a Federation would help eliminate the remote fear and possibility of struggle and war.

To understand this reality, the Federation of Earth would be similar to the 50 states of the United States of America. Each state has its own flag, its own history, its own constitution, its own government, and its own ways of doing things. Yet, the idea that one state can wage a war against another state does not exist even remotely. Besides, there is a great cooperation between such states economically, culturally, educationally, religiously and otherwise. In this regard, the United States may represent a federated planet in miniature.

### Crucial and Important Steps

There several steps that could be taken toward the eventual formation of an effective and beneficial earth's charter. Such a charter must be structured in a way that it would benefit all people from every walk of life and profession in every country without exception. It should reveal deep concern toward creating a new generation of peace through well constructed educational programs and studies for all schools without exception. It should make absolutely sure that the environment everywhere is fully well protected from air and water pollution, which is killing quite a few millions every year through cancer.

Besides, such an Earth Chapter must make sure that violations against human rights would come to an end by all means. In addition, this world document should include ways for the development of an international program of disarmament and arms control. And last but not least, the human resources should be used exclusively for positive and constructive purposes and never for negative and destructive purposes. This means that the human brains



should seek remedies for the solution of such deadly elements as cancer, leukemia, and organized crime the mafia type. People should be viewed as members of the same body: humanity. If one segment suffers, the entire body is thrown in agony.

In addition, the Earth Charter must make sure that drastic steps are taken properly on the elimination of world hunger, the provision of homes to the homeless, and the prevention of exploitation by big business of the natural resources of developing nations. This exploitation is often done at the expense of the native population, like it has been observed in African, Southeast Asian and Latin American nations. We are familiar of the traditional saying that the big fish always swallows the small fish. Traditionally, the rich as a whole always tended to exploit, even mercilessly at times, the poor people. The rich must realize that what goes around comes around. When the poor suffer, in long range the rich are bound to suffer too.

Such an Earth Chapter needs to take into consideration that people from very walk of life and profession are represented, that the government of the respective nations exists not to be served by the people but the other way around. This means the government is there for one purpose only: to serve the people. Hence, the real power, in terms of the structure of needs and priorities, remains the people. Unfortunately, history has thought us that, in spite of a written constitutions to this end, people have been used a guinea pigs for the benefit of the few in the government. Of course, this explains why peace in every era of history has been so difficult to achieve.

### Looking into a Hopeful Future

In his farewell address to the United States Congress, President Eisenhower stated to the US government: "Remember that all people of all countries want peace, only their government wants war". And later he remarked saying:

"People want peace so badly that one day the governments of the world will have no choice but to give it to them". The statement and question that needs to be raised is this: People have waited for centuries to have peace and to cherish it fully throughout their lifetime. How long are people going to wait to get what they want and what they deserve considering that peace is a sacrosanct human right?

In view of what we have learned from history, it is quite obvious that the structure and implementation of an Earth's Chapter is of paramount importance and it is indispensable. The fact that we have so many hungry and poor people in the world, the fact that the leading governments of the world still seek solutions to world problems through weapons of mass destruction and constant wars, and the fact that people's health and education are no longer, on the whole, given top priority reveals a serious threat to human survival. The structure and formation of an Earth's Chapter would eventually take care of these sad facts.

The hope of the world lies in the younger generation of our time. The future members of every government across every continent will be composed of today's younger generation. This generation consists of our present children who are at all levels of education: elementary, secondary, college and universities. It is a generation that is seriously concerned about its future and that it is determined to take any steps needs for a healthy and stable world. The urgency for structure of the Earth's Chapter is a gigantic step in the right direction. Every nation needs to feel obligated to take all needs steps to make this noble document a tangible reality.
