Youth Job Center and Chicago Instruction Center are connecting eligible young adults with free access to a career-launching phlebotomy program. Any required testing, uniforms, or equipment will be provided at no cost, and all classes are free. Admission is rolling and is open to young adults who are between 18 and 24 years old and not currently in school.

The program, offered online or in person, provides participants with a powerful foundation in phlebotomy, covering best-practice techniques, an overview of the current healthcare field, and a sympathetic approach to patients of all ages, backgrounds, and medical conditions.
