

HAVIN' A TREEMENDOUS CHRISTMAS ON THE FARM

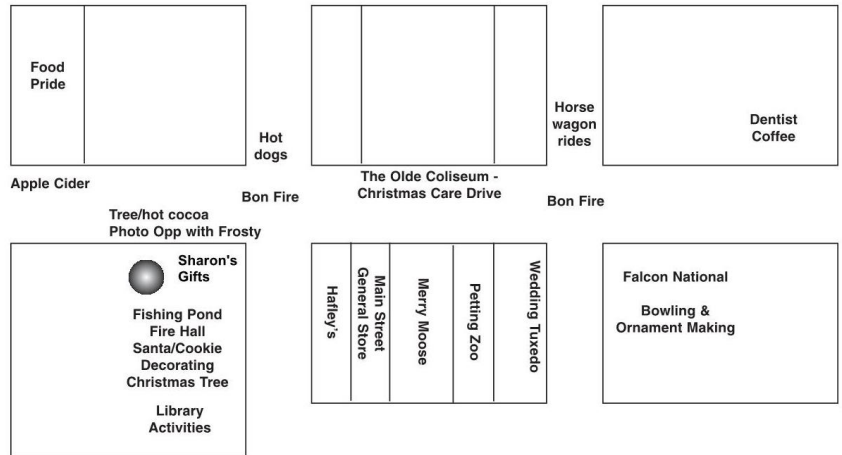


Dear Local Business Owners,
