

# The Great Successes of the Utsalady Ladies Aid Art Tour Luncheon 2010 - 2025

In 1999, the Camano Island Studio Tour began in May. There were only 14 artists that first year. Some 26 years later some of the same artists continue to participate in the tour.

In 2010, the Utsalady Ladies Aid tried their hand at serving sandwiches and soup to the community during the Art Tour. That first year, the Ladies sold 130 sandwiches, 80 turkey, 38 ham and cheese, and 12 vegetarian. Each sold for \$7.00 per lunch. They served Lemonade, coffee and water which we still offer today in 2025. 130 sandwiches sold for \$7.00 each.

In 2012, we sold 148 sandwiches. In 2013, the new price for the sandwich was established at \$8.00. 2021 is the next year



that I have sandwich sales of 289 selling for \$15.00 per sandwich. In 2023, we sold 359 sandwiches at \$15.00 per sandwich. 2024 sales were 338 lunches, at \$15.00 each. We sold 57 bowls of soup with the Whole sandwiches at \$5.00 per bowl. Total Sales were \$5355. The most recent year 2025 we sold 314 sandwiches. Sandwiches sold for \$15.00 each, with soup sales and extra cookie sales the Income was \$5499.00. This does not include expenses.

This is a fantastic success story for all the Ladies Aid and hard working volunteers. I know there were more than 60 volunteers between baking cookies, making soup and all the members that worked in the kitchen or the dining room. Some volunteers worked for 3 days to make this a success.

The proceeds all go to support our building and community. "It takes an Island" or you can say "It takes our Ladies Aid Community" of endless volunteers who work so hard.
