# Outdoor Adventure: Camping

**Project Cost-** One-time fee between \$100-\$150 for the campsite

**Location** - Camping trip likely to be May 30-June 1, 2025. Will be dependent on the campsite availability. One meeting to be held about one month prior to the camping weekend.

**Project Description** - A fun weekend of camping activities, likely to be held at Cosumnes River Ranch in Plymouth, CA. the campsite is also likely to be tent only but will be right on the river and very private. Activities will be planned, including the famous 'cook-off' challenge. This last year's agenda was fishing, gold panning, building boats and a 'hot dip challenge'. There will also be plenty of downtime for members to enjoy their time in nature.

**Project Description** - The Suisun Valley 4-H swine project is for boys & girls that are 9 years old by December 31, 2024. We will purchase pigs sometime between January & February for entry in the Dixon May Fair. For those who want to show at the Solano County Fair, in July, will also have that option. Raising & showing a pig requires dedication, hard work and a little luck. We will learn how to select a sound pig, develop a feeding regime, learn showmanship skills & simple record bookkeeping. This is an experience that members will remember for a lifetime. Members will need to find accommodations for their own animal. A covered stall is essential with an area to roam and root around. Feeding is done twice a day & water should always be available. Cleaning the stall should be done as necessary. Working the pig with a whip is recommended daily to improve your chances of doing well in showmanship. It is helpful if you can transport your own animal to fair but if it's not possible, we will make sure it gets there. The cost of the project will run approximately \$600-700 depending on the quality of animal, feed, equipment, etc. We will have meetings once a month starting in October thru April. In April we may meet weekly until fair time to check weight of animals.

**Safety Component** - Safety will be discussed at the beginning of relevant meetings

**Number of Meeting** - This project will offer a minimum 20 hours; 6 hours are required for 100% attendance.

**Project Cost-** \$50 to \$100.

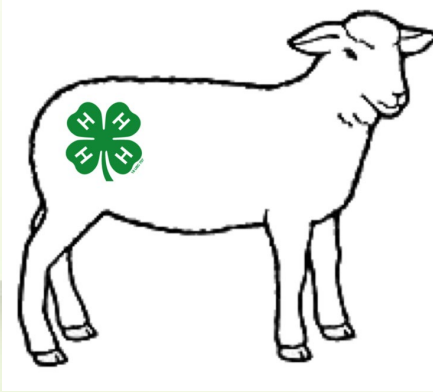
**Location** - County office and my home 3603 Ritchie Rd. Fairfield CA

# Poultry



**Project Description** - The poultry project will cover a variety of topics including: anatomy, biosecurity and poultry maintenance, prevention of virus/disease, proper housing, predator prevention, showmanship knowledge and skills.

This project is intended for junior and senior members. All members will be encouraged to attend a Poultry Show (date TBD – sometime in late January/early February) to see different breeds and varieties of poultry up close. The poultry show is also an excellent time to purchase a showmanship bird for members that do not have one and wish to participate in upcoming fairs and Poultry shows.

Market/meat birds will also be covered and members will have the opportunity to purchase birds in time for Dixon May Fair. We will also cover how to write and deliver bidder letters as well as, following through with animals purchased through auction.

It is not required for members to have their own poultry to join this project, but it is highly recommended. Kids that do have their own showmanship bird in the initial meetings will have an opportunity to use a leader's bird or can practice using a stuffed animal. Showmanship birds are typically bantam breeds for ease of handling the bird in the show ring.

All meetings are approximately 1.5 hours. At least 5 meetings are required, but for maximum learning, all meetings are highly encouraged as they will all discuss different topics of poultry raising and showmanship.
