

The Lowdown On In-Person Lessons

Ventilation

We created a studio space with cross-ventilation so that your aerosols are swept away as quickly as possible. PS, dress warmly, the days are getting colder.

We are ALL Vaccinated

Sanitize all the things

Every student needs to clean the space with sanitizing wipes so that you know that things you are touching are clean!

Optional Steps you can take
