IRON-ON PATCH



instructions



- \bigcirc Suitable for all natural, mixed, and synthetic fibers, that allow ironing with min. medium ($\bullet \bullet$) setting. For other fabrics (low heat (\bullet) setting) we only recommend sewing the patch on.
- Iron the patch from the right side of the fabric: Set your garment/fabric on a hard, heat resistant surface. Set your patch at the desired spot, print facing up and glue side facing down. Check that your garment/fabric lays flat under the patch. Use bakingsheet between the patch and the iron. Iron with medium setting (**) for about 10 seconds, press hard. To finish iron the edges multiple times, press hard. Let the patch cool down and check the edges and make sure the patch is well fixed. Repeat the heat fix treatment if some part did not fix, and if the patch falls off.
- After attaching the patch, wash your garment inside out, in cold water (max. 30 degrees), low tumble. Air dry. Never iron the print from the right side without a baking sheet. Iron with medium heat. Do not bleach. Avoid folding the patch when stored. *CARE TO CARE*
- ♡ Material: Stretch denim (cotton, elastane).
