
# Jones Creek Disc Golf Club Sprint League

The 2025 Jones Creek Disc Golf Club Season will run in Sprint League format, operating 6 individual sixweek sprints kicking off on Saturday, February 8<sup>th</sup>. At the end of the final Sprint, League Champions will be crowned based on the accumulation of points gained across all 6 Sprints.

#### **Sprint League Play**

A Sprint is a series of 6 rounds where players accumulate points based on where they finish in the field. Once all 6 rounds in the Sprint are completed and points are tallied, the Sprint winners will be determined and paid! Only the top 4 rounds for each player will count towards the Sprint point tally. There will be 6 Sprints during the 2025 season, and players accumulate points towards the Sprint League Championship, culminating with the Big Money Mini on November 15<sup>th</sup>!



Sprint Rounds will be played during the normal Saturday Bag Tag minis, or on Sundays for weeks where there are other non-league events at the Jones Creek Disc Golf course (see the Sprint League Schedule). Non-Sprint League competitors are allowed to play in the weekly Rounds and are eligible for the cash payouts, but will not accumulate points towards Sprints or the League Championship.

**Sprint Round Points** - We will be using the UDisc League Scoring System for each Sprint. The bottom 50% of the field in each division will earn 1 point for participating, while the top 50% of finishers will gain additional points depending on where they finished in the standings.

**Sprint Round Point Accumulation** - Only the four best finishes for each player will count towards the Sprint point total. New league sign-ups will be accepted at any point during a Sprint, but no points will be awarded for any rounds prior to signing up.

**Sprint League Championship Point Accumulation -** Sprint winners will accumulate points towards the League Championship. All Sprint finishes accumulate to the Sprint League Championship point totals. Any ties after the conclusion of the final round of a Sprint will be settled by a playoff with the holes to be determined by the TD.

At the completion of the 6 week Sprint, points will be tallied and ties will be resolved to determine the top 3 finishers in each division to determine the Sprint winners. All \$20 Sprint Entry fees collected at during each Sprint will go into the Sprint pot. The 1st place finisher in each division will receive 60% of the Sprint division pot, 2nd place getting 30% and 3rd place getting 10%. For example, if there are 10 players in the Advanced division, there will be \$200 in the ADV Sprint pot. The ADV Sprint winner will receive \$120, 2nd place finisher gets \$60 and 3rd place gets \$20. In the event of a tie for 1st, 2nd or 3rd place,

#### **League Championship Points**

- 1st place = 4 points
- 2nd place = 3 points
- 3rd place = 2 points
- 4th place and below = 1 point

### **Sprint League Divisions**

There are 3 divisions of play in Sprint League:

- Advanced (ADV) >900 PDGA Player Rating
- Intermediate (INT) 850-900 PDGA Player Rating
- Recreational (REC) <850 PDGA Player Rating</li>

Players will declare their division at the beginning of each Sprint. Players may only be promoted at the discretion of the TD after the conclusion of a Sprint depending on their performance (players will not change divisions during the 6 week Sprint). Players may voluntarily demote with the approval of the TD before the start of the next Sprint. The purpose of promotion or demotion is to keep the field level and prevent better players from keeping an advantage by playing down in a lower division. League Championship points will be applied based on the division the played by a player in the final Sprint, but will account for all League points accumulated across all Sprints.

**Example 1:** Player A started in INT, but was demoted to REC before the start of the 4th Sprint after consistently finishing at the bottom of the INT field. That player goes on to win the next 3 REC division Sprints. They will have accumulated 3 points in the Intermediate Division (1 point for each finish below the top 3 places) and 12 points in the Recreational Division (4 points for each 1<sup>st</sup> place finish) and thus finishes the league with 15 points in the Recreational Division Championship.

**Example 2:** Player B started in the Recreation Division and took  $1^{st}$  place in the first Sprint by a large margin. Player B was promoted to the Intermediate Division and finished the League with two  $1^{st}$  place Sprint finishes and three  $2^{nd}$  place Sprint finishes. Player B accumulated 4 points in Recreation (4 points for  $1^{st}$  place) and 17 points in the Intermediate Division (4 points for each

1<sup>st</sup> place finish and 3 points for each 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish) and thus finishes in the Intermediate Division with 21 points in the Intermediate Division Championship.

## **Entry Fees and Payouts**

**\$20 Sprint Entry Fee** for each 6 week Sprint - 100% Sprint cash payouts at the end of each 6 week Sprint. Sprint League fees are not prorated for late entries and are non-refundable.

**\$15 Weekly Round Entry Fee** – weekly cash payouts paying the top 30% of the field – Sprint participation is not required to receive weekly payouts. We have increased the cash payouts in each division.

- \$9 to weekly payout
- \$2 to Ace Pot accumulation
- \$2 to Sprint League Championship payout
- \$1 to weekly cash CTP payouts
- \$1 to club fees

All players will pay into the Sprint League Championship regardless of their participation in the league.

The Sprint League will have a dedicated Ace Pot that is not shared with any other Jones Creek DGC events. The Ace Pot is accumulated weekly and pays out 80% of the Ace Pot total, with 20% of the Ace Pot total carrying over to the next week. All players who have paid the Round Entry Fee are eligible for the full Ace Pot payout (payout is not contingent on club membership).

Casual players (non-paying) are permitted to play on cards during the weekly Rounds, but are not eligible for any cash or prizes and will not accumulate any points towards the Sprints or League Championship. Players who decide to buy in to the Sprint after a round has started will not be allowed to count that round for Sprint League points.

**Weekly Round Payouts** – Weekly rounds payout at the completion of each round. The top 30% of the field in each division will be paid out according to the payout table and is dependent on the number of players each day. A minimum of one cash CTP prize will be paid out weekly, as well, and is based on the total numbers of players.

**Sprint Payouts** – At the completion of the 6 week Sprint, points will be tallied and ties will be resolved to determine the top 3 finishers in each division to determine the Sprint winners. All \$20 Sprint Entry fees collected at during each Sprint will go into the Sprint pot. The 1<sup>st</sup> place finisher in each division will receive 60% of the Sprint division pot, 2<sup>nd</sup> place getting 30% and 3<sup>rd</sup> place getting 10%. For example, if there are 10 players in the Advanced division, there will be \$200 in the ADV Sprint pot. The ADV Sprint winner will receive \$120, 2<sup>nd</sup> place finisher gets \$60 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place gets \$20. In the event of a tie for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> place,

**League Payouts** – At the completion of all 6 Sprints, points will be tallied and ties will be resolved to determine the League Champions in each Division with payouts awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers. \$2 collected every Saturday from the player's Round Entry Fee will be contributed to the Division Pot for the League Championship, to be paid out at the conclusion of the League at the Big Money Mini on November 15, 2025.

#### **Ground Rules**

- Sprint League play will follow the rules of play laid out by the PDGA for tournament play
- All normal OB and Mando rules will be observed.
- Players will create their own cards for each round.
- Every player is allowed one mulligan per round.
- Card members will settle rule disputes or violations in accordance with PDGA standards.
- The Tournament Director will be the final arbiter of any disputes.
