Our consortium collaborated with the FACE project to produce a commercial to raise awareness about opioid misuse and the importance of Narcan in saving lives. The commercial featured Casey Moore from the Upper Peninsula, who became addicted to opioids as a teen after a hockey injury.

Casey shared the story of the night he overdosed and was revived with Narcan from an EMT. He encourages others to reach out for help and puts a local face on opioid misuse. Now four years sober, Casey is a father and small business owner.
