Visitor Policy

Bdote Learning Center values the role that our community members and parents/guardians play in making our school successful. Bdote Learning Center encourages interest on the part of parents and community members in school programs and student activities. Bdote welcomes visits to school buildings and school property by parents and community members provided the visits are consistent with the health, education and safety of students and employees, and are conducted within the procedures and requirements established by the school district.

The school board reaffirms its position on the importance of maintaining a school environment that is safe for students and employees and free of activity that may be disruptive to the student learning process or employee working environment.

All Bdote Learning Center visitors must:

- Sign in at the office when arriving at Bdote Learning Center.
- Obtain and prominently display on their person a visitor's sticker from the office and return the sticker and sign out upon departure.
- Not interfere with any school activity during the visitation.
- Not disrupt or cause disorder to any class, office, or school activity.
- Leave if asked to leave by the Director or Director's designee.

An individual or group may be denied permission to visit the school or school property or such permission may be revoked if the visitor(s) does not comply with the school district procedures and regulations or if the visit is not in the best interest of students, employees or the school district.

An individual or group who enters school property without complying with the procedures and requirements may be guilty of criminal trespass and thus subject to criminal penalty. Such persons may be detained by the school director or a person designated by the school director in a reasonable manner for a reasonable period of time pending the arrival of a police officer.
