The Covid-19 numbers through testing data provided by Hennepin County indicate that the virus has dropped to an acceptable level of management within the district. Bdote Learning Center has provided two clinics for school age children and will continue to work with partners within the Minneapolis community to provide more opportunities for Covid-19 vaccination.
