Bdote Learning Center 1st Annual Dakota Iapi Akiciyapihca Official Rules of Team and Coach Conduct

- 1. Teams must have two members to compete. A student may not be on more than one team.
- 2. All teams must consist of enrolled students of that school. Children from outside that school cannot compete on the school team, regardless of relationships to coach or other players. If a student is competing in a family team or a community, or community agency they will not be allowed to compete with their home school.
- 3. Teams must be checked in by 10 am the day of competition.
- 4. Teams who are not present at the time of their competition will be given a 3-minute grace period. After the 3 minutes if the team has not arrived they forfeit the match.
- 5. Teams are highly encouraged to wear clothes representing their school, family, community or organization they are competing for.
- 6. Good sportsmanship MUST be displayed by all contestants, coach's and spectators. If poor sportsmanship is displayed, said individual or team will be warned, if it happens again said team will be disqualified and asked to leave the competition and premises.
- 7. Teams must be gracious during competition, whether participating or watching, and at the end of every round for head to head competition teams must shake hands with each other.
- 8. Good sportsmanship must be displayed by coach's, contestants, and spectators.
- 9. If a team disagrees with a call, the coach may bring it up with Barry Hand or Liz Cates. "all judges/moderator's decisions are final"
- 10. If an alternate is needed, check them in with judges before competition.
- 11. Contestants are not allowed to hand hover over the buzzer.
- 12. Any cheating during competition will result in immediate disqualification.
