JOB DESCRIPTION:

Bdote Learning Center seeks a Ojibwe Elementary Immersion Teacher who is passionate and dedicated to providing excellent academic support and behavioral management to special education students, among other duties. Ideal candidates have experience with Native American culture and language and experience working with elementary and/or middle school students.

JOB DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Build positive relationships and community with students and families through effective and frequent communication
- Serve as a positive model by exhibiting a high degree of professionalism in all elements of the position
- Plans and implements a variety of learning experiences to meet state and Indian Education curriculum in the medium of Ojibwe language at grade level, as well as experiential hands-on field trips.
- Organizes and scaffolds lesson plans to meet diverse needs of individual students.
- Maintains the documentation and reporting requirements of the school regarding student attendance, special education, behavior, student achievement, and student health.
- Maintains and improves professional competence by participating in faculty meetings, team meetings as a member, in-service training staff committees and other appropriate professional activities.
- Create, implement and monitor progress of each student using formative assessments in the language medium for core subjects with measurements completed beginning, middle, and end of year.
- Analyze, record, and document student examples and assessments to measure growth; complete report cards at the end of the term and hold conferences to communicate student progress with families.
- Works as a part of a team to meet special education modifications, adaptations, and compliance by giving input on individual learning plans and attending meetings.
