Use this bingo sheet as a fun prompt to encourage appropriate socialisation with your puppy.

Play Cardboard Chaos in a new environment	Go for a walk with your puppy with a friend's confident, puppy safe older dog	Go on a field trip to a car park and reward your puppy for observing calmly	Set up an obstacle course in your living room and support your puppy while they navigate it!	Use your puppy's daily food rations to reward them for any display of calm behaviour in the house
Play games like Orientation with your puppy in the garden for 3 minutes	Have a short 60 second session on body handling Stroke gently and Reward, Rinse and Repeat	Play Boundary Games with your Puppy in a new location*	Have a session of Did you hear that? It's no big deal! During a mealtime.	Take your puppy to a new location with minimal distraction and play Two Feet On
Independent Exploration Set up novelty items in a room, sprinkle some food, and enjoy the show!	Play a shaping game with your puppy's collar or harness. Show it to them and reward them when they interact!	FEE	Play Middle in a new location! Lure your puppy so that they are between your legs whilst standing.	Aeroplane Feed in a new location. Aeroplane feeding is slow treat delivery. Find out more in NBN Core!
Give your puppy an awesome, and long lasting, chew while the dish washer runs	Field Trip to a low distraction location where dogs or people can be observed from a distance!	Go on a walk with your puppy on a 3–4 meter line, reward every time your puppy chooses you!	Pup your puppy in a crate in the car. Reward for calm. Maybe you go somewhere maybe you don't!	Intro to Water Confidence! Let your puppy determine how fast the introduction goes.
Play games in the garden and reward a calm response with any environ- mental changes.	Focus on rewarding calm in the crate or ex-pen, and give your puppy a long-lasting chew while you vacuum in a separate room.	Join the Sexier than a Squirrel Challenge for 30 days of game-filled fun!	Read a book out loud or listen to a podcast out loud while you sit in a chair near your puppy's crate /ex-pen.	Take a field trip where the primary goal is just to play three games in a new location and then celebrate your success!
