

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to www.advancedroboticsusa.com, and Advanced Robotics USA, a DBA of Scientific Florida Technologies LLC, and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to Advanced Robotics USA include www.advancedroboticsusa.com, Advanced Robotics USA, Scientific Florida Technologies LLC, Scientific Florida Inc, www.scientificfloridatechnologies.com, and www.scientificflorida.com. The Advanced Robotics USA website is an E-Commerce site. By using the Advanced Robotics USA website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

To better provide you with products and services offered, Advanced Robotics USA may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

- First and Last Name
- Mailing Address
- E-mail Address

If you purchase Advanced Robotics USA's products and services, we collect billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete the purchase transaction.
