












# GIVE WAY RULES GUIDE

Note: this simplified rules guide is for easy reference only. The official IBRA rules document and any NOR modifications override this reference sheet

<div><div>Opposite Tacks (E.1)</div><div>Port tack (wind from left) gives way to Starboard tack (wind from right)</div><div></div></div>	<div><div>Same Tack 1 Overlapped (E.2)</div><div>Blokart to windward keeps clear</div><div></div></div>	<div><div>Same Tack 2 Not Overlapped (E.3)</div><div>Blokart behind keeps clear</div><div></div></div>	<div><div>Continuing Obstruction (E.11)</div><div>A blokart cannot be forced into a continuing obstruction</div><div></div></div>
<div><div>Tacking &amp; Gybing (E.7)</div><div>Keep clear while in the act of tacking or gybing</div><div></div></div>	<div><div>Changing Course (E.5)</div><div>Avoid sudden changes in course, give others room to keep clear</div><div></div></div>	<div><div>Downwind vs Upwind (E.8)</div><div>Blokart on a downwind leg keep clear of blokart on an upwind leg</div><div></div></div>	<div><div>Race Start (E.17a)</div><div>There is no-overlap rule and windward blokart must keep clear. Even if this means missing the start line</div><div></div></div>
<div><div>Marks &amp; Obstructions 1 Overlapped at Zone (E.9)</div><div>Outside blokart gives way</div><div></div></div>	<div><div>Marks &amp; Obstructions 2 Not Overlapped at Zone (E.10)</div><div>Blokart behind gives way &amp; keeps clear</div><div></div></div>	<div><div>Marks &amp; Obstructions 3 On Opposite Tacks (E.10)</div><div>Port tack (wind from left) gives way to Starboard tack (wind from right)</div><div></div></div>	<div><div>REMEMBER</div><div>Avoid collisions (E.4)</div><div>Look ahead and Anticipate other's actions</div><div>When you don't have rights yield early</div><div>When you have rights make predictable changes in course</div></div>
