All members upon joining CQBC agree that they will at all times abide by the rules set down below:

1. Riders take part in club activities in accordance with Club By-Laws, and also with IBRA rules of racing (when applicable).
2. Avoidance of collisions should always be the number **1** priority of all sailors, in all circumstances.
3. All equipment used on club events must be sound & compliant with IBRA safety standards.
4. Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied and cared for by a parent /guardian (or other responsible adult appointed by the parent /guardian) at all times. That person will be responsible to maintain the child's safety, including determining their ability to drive solo in a blokart.
5. For safety, helmets, seatbelts and closed-in footwear must be used by all sailors/riders whilst in Blokarts.
6. Always promote the family-friendly image of the club & the spirit of good sportsmanship.
7. Respect and consideration should be shown towards all other persons in and near the sailing area. Take care not to endanger nor alarm other beach-goers.
8. Care shall always be taken to minimise disturbance to other beach users and wildlife. Natural flora and fauna of the areas where activities occur will not be interfered with.
9. As per Qld law; alcohol consumption is not permitted in public spaces, and no person shall ride if intoxicated with alcohol or any other drug.
10. Offensive language or gestures will not be tolerated on any club activities.
11. Fighting, threatening and other disorderly conduct will not be permitted and the Club reserves the right to terminate the membership of any person who violates the law or the by- laws of the club.
12. Non-club members are to acknowledge safety rules and sign a waiver, & **MUST** be instructed on the basic operations of the Blokart by a knowledgeable club member prior to any trial sailing being undertaken.
13. Club property is to be treated with respect.
14. The club President and other appointed officials have the authority to enforce additional rules relevant to the conditions at the time of an event i.e. safety issues, weather conditions, ground conditions, etc.
15. The Club 'Management Committee', at a minimum, will consist of: President, Secretary, Treasurer, & ABA delegate.
16. These delegates have the responsibility to conduct the day-to-day business of the club and also the authority to make emergency decisions on behalf of the members of the Club where a special general meeting cannot be convened in a suitable amount of time. These decisions must be minuted and tabled at the next club meeting & must be made in the best interests of the club. A minimum of three execs are required to be in agreement before a decision can be made.
17. Additional 'Committee' positions may be added at a General Club meeting, and may consist of: [for example] extra ABA delegate/s or chairs of any committees the club may have. The 'Committee' positions may change from year to year and at any time, as the club sees fit.

18. Any sub committees formed within the Club must have at least one Management Committee member on that committee.
19. Any complaints regarding club matters or the running of events must be submitted in writing and tabled at a Club meeting.
