

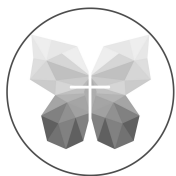

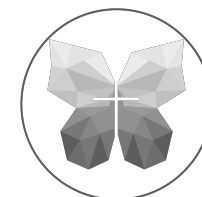

The Pentateuch

Deuteronomy 6:4-9 | The Rev. Tim Sisk

Our sermon series, Binge Reading the Bible, begins with the Pentateuch. The Pentateuch (Greek for Five Scrolls) refers to the first five books of the Bible. This section of scripture is also known as the Torah or the Law. In this section of scripture we can understand the will and desires of God for his people as he reveals himself to humanity through creation, the law, and relationships. Our reading this morning contains the *Shema*, Deuteronomy 6:4 (Hear O Israel: the Lord our God, the Lord is one.), which was expected by observant Jews to be recited twice daily. It is followed by the sum of the law in Deuteronomy 6:5-6: "Love, the Lord your God with all your heart, all your being, and all your strength. These words that I am commanding you today must always be on your mind."
