DICE BASEBALL GAME RULES

Both Players roll a die, and whoever rolls the highest number gets to pick to be the home or visiting team.

Player 1 will roll both dice. Add the two numbers together and use the board to determine the outcome. Place your player marker on the bases accordingly. (If you hit a double, place your marker at second base)

When there are runners on base, the runners can move around the bases according to the new batter's outcome.

Once a player makes 3 outs, then his turn is over, and the next player is up. Each player will get 3 outs before moving onto the next inning.

Play 9 innings to see who wins.

Home Run-All advance to Home
Double-Runners Advance 2 Bases, Batter takes 2nd
Fly Out-Batter Out
Walk-Batter Walks to First
Pop Out-Batter Out
Single-Runners Advance, Batter takes 1st
Double Play-Automatic 2 outs, any pre-existing runners remain
Ground Out-Batter Out
Strike Out- Batter Out
Single-Runners Advance 1 Base
Triple-Runners advance, Batter takes 3rd
Sacrifice Fly-Batter Out, Runners advance one base
