Saturday September 12th, anytime between 9am and 1pm, bring your old shoes and small handmade signs with climate messages, if you'd like, and place them on the front lawn of the First Parish Meeting House, while maintaining safe social distancing. Extra cardboard and markers will be available for making signs on site. The shoe-in demonstration will remain staffed and on view for residents to visit until 5pm. Shoes can be picked up any time after 5pm.

We expect a spectacular 8 hour display of solidarity!

IF YOU CAN'T STOP BY ON SATURDAY...

On Friday September 11th, drop off shoe donations gathered from neighbors, friends, and family to the front porch of the U House next to the church. Include your small, hand-made signs with a climate message tucked inside shoes, and we will display them for you.

(NOTE: Retrieve your shoes at/after 5pm Saturday evening. All shoes remaining on Sunday morning will be gathered by volunteers and donated to charities.)

SHOE-IN is a safe, effective, way to show our concern about the climate crisis and to highlight the steps we can take locally, particularly when a sit-in or a march is not possible due to COVID and public health safety concerns.
