Many thanks for the Scotch tasting that was organized by Alex Nowak, and presented by Jim Patterson, both a Club member and a professional Whiskey expert. The updated document will replace the current Constitution and By-Laws that were amended in 2008 and 2011.

Not less than one week before the May Membership meeting, the 2017 Bylaws document will be sent by email to all

members with email addresses. For those who do not have an email address, copies of the 2017 document will be available at the Club.

At the May Membership meeting (May 10th), Bylaws Ratification Committee chairman Dick Wellbrock, and committee members Joe Horling, Joan Huber and Al Nemeth will announce that at the June meeting (June 14th) the 2017 Bylaws document will be voted for approval as is. The procedure at the May meeting will be to discuss and answer any questions regarding the proposed Bylaws. The proposed document represents a significant improvement over the current Bylaws, and also satisfies State requirements.

It should be noted that amendments are anticipated and the process for doing so is indicated in XVII of the 2017 document. Thank you to all who have participated in the creation of this 2017 document. The Vorstand and I ask each of the members to vote for the adoption of this document, understanding that its creation took much effort, thought, care and legal input. Thank you as always for your support.

You'll also notice the change in the newsletter to include more German Cultural articles, as well as a "German word or phrase of the week", already on our Face-book page. Please check the inside of the bulletin for the many events and trips available to our Club members. The summer season is also coming up, so please sign up early to volunteer at the events! Remember, it's your Club, so get involved and take advantage of it!



BLOOD DRIVE NEWS

Our last Blood Drive was Saturday, March 4. The Community Blood Center again was the service collecting blood for processing and distribution to many local hospitals.

We collected 41 pints of whole blood from the 39 individuals who attended the blood drive. Every drive will have individuals who cannot donate on a particular day because of travel or medication usage of various other reasons. Because of the support the Deutscher Club has always offered to the blood center we qualify to receive the ALYX System of collecting blood. The ALYX System collects two pints of red blood and returns the other components, plasma and white blood cells, back to your system. ALYX also uses a smaller needle insuring a more comfortable donation.

Many members have questions if they can donate if they travel on vacation or if certain medications may inhibit them from donating.

Potential donors ask if there is an age limit for donors. Recently the FDA in New Jersey approved no age limit or Doctor's note needed to give blood in NJ. All Blood Donors must report any medical problems so that a determination can be made as to their ability to donate. Members and non-members only need to show up, complete a short questionnaire, donate your pint of blood, if capable; then relax and enjoy a light German lunch and lively conversation with fellow members and donors.
