We would like to thank our member Joe Weuste for his craftsmanship by encasing our Imperial War Flag which hangs in the Ratskeller.



The Imperial War Ensign

1903-1919 Flag was donated on November 25, 2006 by one time members Dr. and Mrs. Leonard Eckle.

With the able assistance of Carol Dunlop (Computer Analyst), Paula Mooney (Fine Arts Appraiser) and Commander Richard Madden (Retired Annapolis Naval Officer) it has been determined that this Flag is definitely an authentic German Imperial Naval Flag of the 1916 war era.

It is claimed that this Flag flew on the Cruiser of Gross Admiral Reinhard Scheer at the 1916 Great Naval Battle of Skagerrak, or as we know it, the Battle of Jutland.

Deutschland hatte vor kurzem einen Wettbewerb, in dem sich 400 Konkurrentinnen um eine Chance beworben hatten, als erste Astronautin in die

deutsche Geschichte der Raumfahrt einzugehen. Die Kampfpilotin Nicola Baumann und die Meteorologin Insa Thiele Eich waren die zwei Erwählten, aber nur eine von ihnen wird in 2020 an einer 10-tägigen Forschungsmission auf der internationalen Raumstation ISS teilnehmen. Die andere ist die Ersatzkandidatin. Beide Frauen sind aktiv im Training für die kommende Mission.



In a recent contest Germany had 400 contestants who vied for the chance to be the first female astronaut to be listed in the history of Germany's space travel. The fighter pilot Nicola Bauman and the meteorologist Insa Thiele Eich were the two chosen ones, but only one will participate in 2020 in the 10-day research mission on the international space station ISS. The other one is the replacement candidate. Both women are actively in training for the coming mission.
